8 Questions to Ask BEFORE Hiring a Service Provider



1.	Based on Autism Ontario's "What to Look For" tipsheet for that service, do they provide the support that you and your family need?
2.	Do they have experience working with a client with similar needs?
3.	Can they outline all expected costs and deliverables (what you should expect to receive)?
4.	Can they provide a current clear Vulnerable Sector Check?
5.	For regulated health professions and credential-holding ABA providers, are they listed in good standing on the <u>appropriate regulatory body website</u> ?
6.	Can they provide references (past clients ideally, colleagues also acceptable)?
7.	Can they provide a contract for you to review and sign BEFORE service begins?
8.	Are they a good fit for the needs and values* of your family?



*Be sure to share your goals and any cultural considerations with the prospective provider to ensure that they align with what the provider can offer!
