

WELCOME TO THE 22ND ANNUAL HWY 62 OPEN STUDIO ART TOURS, brought to you by the Morongo Basin Cultural Arts Council. Artists, working in all mediums, open their studio doors to share their process and bodies of work with visitors far and wide. Although a majority of the studios are located along paved roads, there are many located off the beaten path in uniquely inspirational spots accessible by unpaved dirt roads. We invite you to use the directions in the catalog or GPS to navigate to the studios on your selfguided tour. As you traverse HWY 62, you'll notice the numbered road signs and arrows dotting the highway, pointing you to where you want to go.

the Artists Collective Show at the 29 Palms Art Gallery located at 74055 Cottonwood Drive, Twentynine Palms, CA 92277. The Collective Show is a sample of what the artists have to offer and will showcase the breadth of work of the participating artists.

THE SEEDS OF OUR MODERN OPEN STUDIO ART TOURS were planted back on April 7, 1969 by the 29 Palms Artist Guild as the Palm Sunday Art Tour, with five open studios. The last Palm Sunday Studio tour was held in 1980. In 2000-2001, Lucia Grossberger-Morales began the revival of the modern studio tour. The following year, Chuck Caplinger, Michael Callan, Owen & Audrey Gillick, Kit Brooks, Cathy Svetla, Linda Schrader, and Spelman Evans Downer created the Morongo Basin Cultural Arts Council to produce the 2002 Desert Arts Festival.

THIS 10-DAY EVENT featured about 47 Artists in their respective studios, during alternating weekends between the east and west ends of the Morongo Basin. Music, dance, and theatre performances were also held during the 10-day festival, giving artists and visitors a fun-filled time to remember in our desert. Over the years, the Desert Arts Festival has evolved to become the HWY 62 Open Studio Art Tours, which takes place over three weekends each October.

GIVEN THE ABSENCE of a single Director, the MBCAC board has chosen to work as a cooperative committee to combine all of the best ideas and experience from past years, with the specialized expertise of board members and volunteers to plan, organize, and launch this year's event.

ABOUT THE HWY 62 OPEN STUDIO ART TOURS

The HWY 62 Open Studio Art Tours is an annual multi-disciplinary desert-wide open studio art tour and one of the largest events of this kind in California. The concept of open studio events in itself is a fairly common thing. But in our desert environment with questionable GPS, handpainted or missing road signs, and vast vistas to the edge of the earth, the open studio becomes an extraordinary thing.

HOW TO USE THIS CATALOG

PACE YOURSELF

Although the Art Tours are held over three weekends, it's unlikely that anyone would be able to visit every single studio listed in this catalog. There are 179 artists working in 126 studios spread over hundreds of square miles across the Morongo Basin. Who would want to rush their visit when they find an artist they really resonate with? Besides, in the beautiful high desert, getting there is part of the fun! So it will require some diligent planning to see everything you wish to see.
