1. He is your Helper

CENTRAL SCRIPTURE | JOHN 16 VS 7

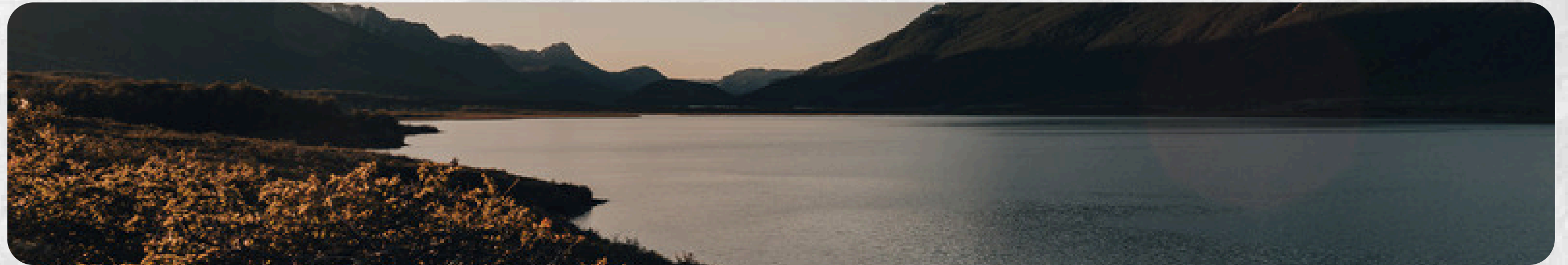
"Nevertheless I tell you the truth. It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you."

At times the flesh may fight for control, it's then that the Spirit steps in and helps us to be who God created us to be.

ADDITIONAL READING | ROMANS 7 VS 15

"For what I am doing, I do not understand. For what I will to do, that I do not practice; but what I hate, that I do."

2. He sanctifies you



Central Scripture | I Corinthians 6 vs 11

“And such were some of you. But you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God.”

Additional Reading | II Corinthians 5 vs 17

“Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.”

The Holy Spirit wants to assist you the process of sanctification: to die to your old self and be all that God created you to be; to be free from the entanglement of sin and live victoriously.

Central Scripture | II Corinthians 3 vs 18

“But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord.”

Additional Reading | Genesis 1 vs 26

“Then God said, “Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth.””

Our goal is to return back to our original blueprint; to be like God. This process occurs through the power of the Holy Spirit. While we focused on sanctification and the diminishment of sin in the previous point, this is rather a transformation into the image of Christ.

3. He makes you more like Christ.

4. He helps you to do the Father's will.

CENTRAL SCRIPTURE | ACTS 8 VS 29-30

[29] "Then the Spirit said to Philip, "Go near and overtake this chariot." [30] So Philip ran to him, and heard him reading the prophet Isaiah, and said, "Do you understand what you are reading?"

The Holy Spirit helps us tune into the voice of the Father and, in faith, do what we believe He is calling us to. Ask the Spirit to show you what the Father's will would be for you today and ask Him to empower you to carry it out!

ADDITIONAL READING:

II Corinthians 3:17

"Now the Lord is the Spirit; and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty."

John 10 vs 27

"My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me."

5. He imparts love

Central Scripture | Romans 5:3-5

[3] “And not only that, but we also glory in tribulations, knowing that tribulation produces perseverance; [4] and perseverance, character; and character, hope. [5] Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us.”

Additional Reading | John 14 vs 15

““If you love Me, keep My commandments.”

We find love in our suffering. As we endure trials, God’s love is poured out into us through the Spirit and it’s this empowerment that carries you and I through the hard seasons. When you are doubting this love in your difficulty, remember that the Spirit pours it into your heart.
