# SCENES

## PRELUDE

### **Shipwreck. The Middle of the Adriatic Sea**

Full Company

Twins, Viola and Sebastian, travel by ship from their hometown of Messaline to start a new life in Illyria, after the death of their father, when a storm strikes...

### **ACT I, scene i. Count Orsino's Lounge**

Count Orsino & his Crew—Cordelia, Valentine, Curio, and Cecily.

Meet the Duke of Illyria—and infamous bachelor—Count Orsino and his Crew. The Count is finally ready to settle down, and pines for Lady Olivia. To win her heart, he instructs his Crew to go woo the Lady while trying to find the perfect song to match his lovesick heart.

### **ACT I, scene ii. Coast of Illyria**

Viola, Captain Antonia, Sailors

After being rescued from the storm and shipwreck by Captain Antonia, Viola quizzes her and the Sailors about the fate of Sebastian and the land she has come to. Eager to share, the Sailors begin to divulge the latest town gossip, giving Viola an idea...

### **ACT I, scene iii. Lady Olivia's Foyer**

Maria, Sir Toby, Lady Andie

Sir Toby Belch stumbles in late-night to find Maria (Handmaid to Lady Olivia AND Toby's love interest)—who warns him that Olivia is done with his drunken shenanigans. Sir Toby is focused on the pending arrival of his “dear” friend, Lady Andrea Aguecheek (aka Andie), whom he hopes might take a shot at winning Olivia's heart...or at least provide some good entertainment.

### **ACT I, scene iv. Count Orsino's Lounge**

Count Orsino, his Crew, Cesario

Viola, disguised as a young boy named Cesario, is now happily employed by Count Orsino and has quickly become the favorite employee. Orsino, noting Cesario's way with words, decides to have another go at wooing Olivia and sends Cesario off to do the dirty work.

### **ACT I, scene v. Lady Olivia's Foyer**

Maria, Feste the Fool, Lady Olivia, Malvolio, Sir Toby, Cesario

A typical day in the House of Olivia: Maria and Feste clean up a huge mess (presumably left by one Sir Toby and Lady Andie) while Maria tries to divulge where Feste has been. Lady Olivia finally makes an appearance(!) and is less than thrilled with Feste, but can never help herself from partaking in a battle of wits with the clever Fool. And, the sour Malvolio (Butler to Lady O) immediately shows his true colors with his disdainful and insulting remarks for anyone but Olivia. But their normal routine is soon interrupted by a visitor who will not take no for an answer.

## **ACT II, scene i. Captain Antonia's Sea Shanty**

Sebastian & Antonia

Meanwhile, a few hours from Illyria, Antonia returns to her home to find Sebastian (whom she's been hiding since she rescued him) packing up to head out. When she asks him where he's headed, they ultimately share secrets they've been hiding from each other in the three months since the shipwreck.

## **ACT II, scene ii. Lady Olivia's Terrace**

Malvolio & Cesario

As per Lady Olivia's instructions, Malvolio calls Cesario back to "return" a ring supposedly given to Olivia by Cesario on behalf of Orsino...

## **ACT II, scene iii. Lady Olivia's Foyer**

Sir Toby, Lady Andie, Feste, Maria, Malvolio

Following a wild night out, Sir Toby and Lady Andie land back at Lady Olivia's where they are met by the fool and rowdy shenanigans ensue in the wee hours of the morning...but Maria's warnings aren't enough to quell their raucousness. Which brings the fun-hating Malvolio into the picture. As per usual, he sparks so much ire in the rest of the household that Maria has decided she's had enough and takes a page from Sir Toby's book.

## **ACT II, scene iv. Count Orsino's Lounge**

Count Orsino, his Crew, Cesario, Feste

Count Orsino, doing his usual—reclining on his chaise listening to music—requests a particular song that he heard the night before and sends some of his Crew off to locate Feste. Moved by the soulful performance from Feste, Count Orsino again requests that Cesario set off on another mission to woo the Lady Olivia, but before "he" heads out, the two debate who feels heart ache worse: men or women?

## **ACT II, scene v. Lady Olivia's Courtyard & Gardens**

Sir Toby, Lady Andie, Fabiana, Maria, Malvolio

As she promised earlier, Maria is putting her revenge on Malvolio into action! She drops a mysterious love letter in the garden, supposedly written by Lady Olivia, for Malvolio to find. Sir Toby, Lady Andie, and Fabiana hide nearby to watch as Malvolio finds, reads, and tries to make sense of it.

**Continue on for Act III!**

---

**ACT III, scene i. Lady Olivia's Courtyard & Gardens**

Cesario, Feste, Sir Toby, Lady Andie, Lady Olivia, Maria

Cesario arrives back at Lady Olivia's to find Feste rocking out by herself in the courtyard. After a brief battle of wits, Feste heads inside to find the Lady and, while waiting for her, Cesario is accosted by Lady Andie and Sir Toby. Lady Olivia enters the garden and sends everyone away but Cesario so they can have a private chat.

**ACT III, scene ii. Lady Olivia's Foyer**

Sir Toby, Lady Andie, Fabiana, Maria

Discouraged by Lady Olivia's interest in Cesario, Lady Andie decides she wants to go home much to the dismay of Sir Toby and Fabiana and instead they convince Andie to challenge Cesario to a fight! Maria joins them in excitement to report that Malvolio has indeed taken every point of the fake love letter seriously!

**ACT III, scene iii. An Alley in Illyria**

Sebastian & Antonia

Lovesick Antonia finds herself in Illyria, chasing after Sebastian, despite his request that she not follow him on his journey and that she is a wanted person. They plan to meet back at their lodging and Sebastian heads off for some sightseeing, while Antonia goes to secure a room.

**ACT III, scene iv, part one. Lady Olivia's Sitting Room**

Lady Olivia, Maria, Malvolio, Servant to Olivia, Sir Toby, Fabiana, Lady Andie, Cesario

Melancholy Lady Olivia waits impatiently for Cesario, who has promised to return—when Maria shares that Malvolio seems very...out of sorts. When he shows up smiling, costumed, and making wild declarations to Olivia, she declares him mad and tells Maria to have Sir Toby attend to him while she heads to meet Cesario, who has finally arrived. Sir Toby, Fabiana, and Maria enter and treat Malvolio as if he's gone insane. He storms off, and enter Lady Andie, with a freshly written challenge for Cesario. Back to Lady Olivia who is finally ready to share her full self with Cesario.

**ACT III (continued), scene iv, part two. Courtyard & Gardens**

Cesario, Lady Andie, Sir Toby, Fabiana, Captain Antonia, Officers

Having just left her latest tête-à-tête with Lady O, Viola heads outside when she is met by Lady Andie, Sir Toby, and Fabiana—who are clearly looking for a fight. Antonia happens by and sees someone familiar...thinking it's Sebastian, she intervenes on his behalf, until the local Officers arrive on the scene.

**ACT IV, scene i. Lady Olivia's Courtyard & Gardens**

Sebastian, Feste, Sir Toby, Lady Andie, Fabiana, Lady Olivia

This time it's Feste confusing Sebastian and Cesario, and she can't figure out why Cesario would pretend not to know her! But, when Lady Andie, Toby and Fabiana arrive, Feste knows there is trouble afoot.

**ACT IV, scene ii. Lady Olivia's Cellar**

Malvolio, Maria, Feste, Sir Toby

Poor Malvolio! What started as a minor, but vengeful prank turns into a dark and torturous hoax where Malvolio finds himself locked in a cupboard visited by a Priest attempting to exorcise him!

**ACT IV, scene iii. Lady Olivia's Courtyard & Gardens**

Lady Olivia, Sebastian, Judge

Sebastian waits for Lady Olivia and ponders their earlier meeting...not quite understanding why she took to him so quickly when she arrives with a Judge...

**ACT V, scene i. Lady Olivia's Courtyard & Gardens**

Feste, Fabiana, Count Orsino, Cesario, Cordelia, Valentine, Captain Antonia, Officers, Lady Olivia, Judge, Sebastian, Lady Andie, Sir Toby, Malvolio

Much to the shock of the community, all the truths are revealed, multiple love matches discovered, and the siblings reunited!

**EPILOGUE**

**Castle on a Hill. Lady Olivia's Courtyard & Gardens**

Full Company

With all the drama, chaos, and mistaken identities resolved, the Illyrian community comes together to toast the nuptials of Viola & Count Orsino and Lady Olivia & Sebastian (and maybe even Sir Toby & Maria's elopement...) and delight us with a song!

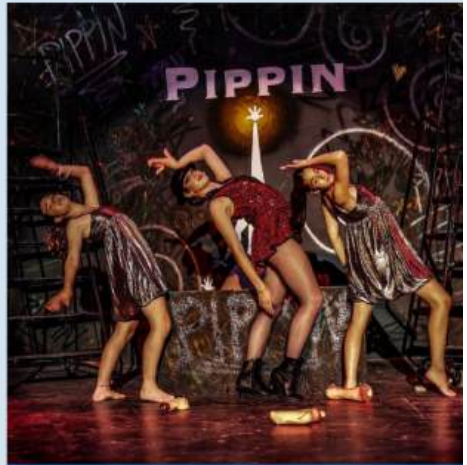

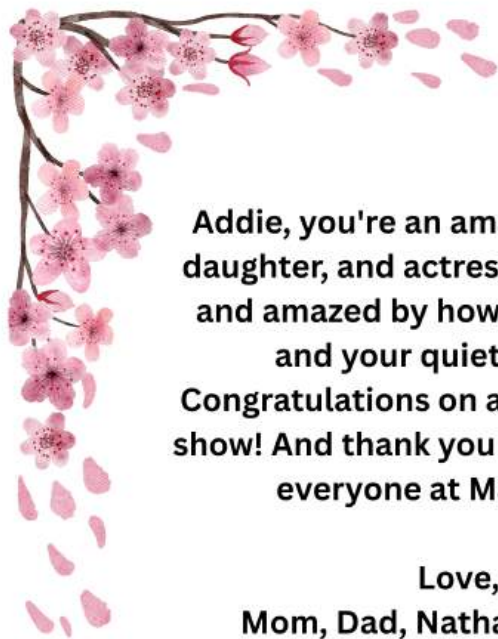
