




Required tools:

- a. Socket and wrench for winch fairlead bracket (Factory offered Warn is 17mm socket for the nut and 5% for the bolt)
- b. 10mm socket
- c. 4mm Allen socket or Allen key
- d. Trim removal tool
- e. T30 torx socket or T30 Key

Included parts:

- A. (1) Camera Relocation Bracket
- B. (1) Camera Mounting Bracket
- C. (1) Rubber Washer Hose
- D. (1) Camera Extension Harness
- E. (2) Washer Hose Couplers (only 1 is required for installation, we include an extra just in case you lose one)
- F. (2) 4-20 Allen Head Bolts





- 1. If you have not already installed your winch, do so first before starting.
- 2. Start by popping the bonnet or hood of your Bronco and removing the plastic trim panel shown in (F1) using (d).
- 3. Disconnect the camera harness and the washer hose. To release the washer hose connector, pinch the long ends of it shown in (F2).
- 4. Remove the (4) 10mm bolts securing the top of the grille using (b) and pull the grille outwards away from the Bronco one side at a time.
- 5. On the backside of the grill, remove the (3) T30 bolts using (e) shown in (F3).
- 6. Disconnect the camera harness and washer hose from the end of the pressure switch as shown in (F4). The pressure switch will be difficult to remove, carefully twist until removed.
- 7. Note: The harness and washer hose attached to the grille will remain attached and will no longer be utilized. To keep the wires and hose out of sight, we zip-tied them as shown in (F6).
- 8. Leaving the grille off, connect the supplied (C) (connect (C) using one supplied (E) coupler) and (D) harness to the factory connectors next to the passenger headlight shown in (F7).
- 9. Then route the included (C) and (D) harness down behind the passenger headlight, through the bumper, and under the winch bracket as shown in (F8-F10).
- 10. After having the harness and hose routed, zip-tie out of sight.
- 11. Place the camera inside of the factory camera bracket as shown in (F11).
- 12. Place camera bracket with camera onto the (A) bracket with (B) bracket placed on top shown in F(12) using (F) bolts, tighten them down.
- 13. Loosen the fairlead nuts and bolts enough to slide the (A) bracket behind it.
- 14. Connect the retained pressure switch from step (7) to the end of the supplied washer hose then connect the harness and pressure switch to the back of the camera.
- 15. Tighten the fairlead nuts and bolts after adjusting the relocation into position.
- 16. Test the cameras functionality and washer hose for leaks, then replace the grille and plastic trim panel.
