INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Before beginning work on any firearm, remove the ammunition source and double check to ensure the chamber is empty.

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- Remove the bolt from the action and the action from the stock.
- 3 Using a punch and hammer, drive out the roll pins holding the trigger in the action. Then remove the trigger assembly from the action.
- With the trigger removed and on safe, push in the safety plunger then carefully remove the e-clip and the bolt lock pin. Remove the safety connecting bar and safety button, then remove the safety plunger and spring. Save these parts for the next step.
- 5 On the new Timney Trigger, insert the safety button and safety connecting bar, then insert the safety plunger and spring. Finally, insert the bolt lock pin and secure it with the e-clip.
- 6 Now it's time to install your Timney Trigger! Slide the Timney Trigger into the action and align the pin holes on trigger housing with the mounting holes on the action. Using the punch, tap in the roll pins.
- Insert the bolt and check the function of the safety, bolt lock, and trigger. Then reinstall the stock.
- 8 You are now ready to enjoy your Timney Trigger!











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
