1. Always showing kindness and respect to everyone equally
2. Supporting and listening to each other and checking in to make sure our friends and those around us as are not experiencing bullying behaviour
3. Taking responsibility for our own behaviour and committing to always being the best version of ourselves
4. Acting quickly if we see, or experience, bullying behaviour so we are not a bystander
5. Telling someone – a responsible person we trust - if we are concerned about bullying behaviour
6. Being positive role models for those around us, during our time at GSC Auldhouse and in the wider community
