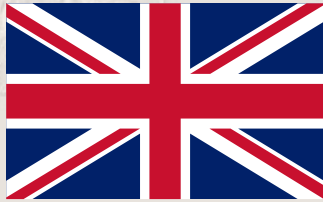

The month of overcoming
DEMONIC ATTACKS

LUKE 10:19

"I have given you authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy; nothing will harm you."

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MONTH OF OVERCOMING DEMONIC ATTACKS

As we enter the month of July, we focus on overcoming demonic attacks. Many believers are unaware of the level of authority they have in Christ, and as a result, they live under unnecessary oppression, fear, and confusion. The truth is that Jesus has already given victory over the enemy. This month is a call to rise in awareness, authority, and spiritual strength. You are not called to be defeated, but to overcome.

Understanding the Month of Overcoming Demonic Attacks

1. Believers Have Authority Over the Enemy

Jesus clearly states that authority has been given. Kenneth Hagin taught that “authority over the devil belongs to every believer, not just a few.” This authority is not based on feelings but on what Christ has accomplished.

2. Demonic Attacks Are Real but Limited

The enemy operates, but within limits. Watchman Nee explained that “the enemy cannot go beyond what God allows, and the believer is never left without victory in Christ.”

3. Ignorance Gives the Enemy Advantage

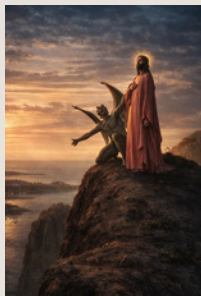
Many suffer because they lack understanding. Charles G. Finney taught that “truth exposes the works of darkness.” Knowledge of your authority is essential.

4. Victory is Rooted in Christ's Finished Work

You do not fight for victory; you fight from victory. Dr Yonggi Cho emphasised that “Christ has already won, and the believer enforces that victory.”

5. This Month is a Call to Spiritual Strength

God is calling you to rise above fear, confusion, and oppression. You are an overcomer.

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WITCHCRAFT IS REAL: SIGNS YOU ARE BEWITCHED AND HOW TO OVERCOME

Witchcraft is a reality that the Bible does not ignore. It is a work of darkness designed to influence, control, and deceive. However, believers must never approach this subject with fear, but with authority and understanding. The power of God is greater than any form of witchcraft. The key is to recognise its signs and stand firm in Christ.

Understanding Witchcraft and How to Overcome

1. Witchcraft Seeks to Control and Manipulate

Kenneth Hagin taught that “witchcraft is often rooted in control, manipulation, and domination.” It can operate subtly through influence, not just rituals.

2. Confusion and Sudden Spiritual Weakness Can Be Signs

Watchman Nee emphasised that sudden confusion, loss of spiritual hunger, or unusual oppression may indicate spiritual interference.

3. The Word of God Breaks Every Spell

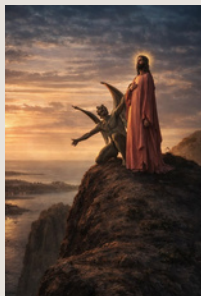
Charles G. Finney taught that truth destroys deception. The Word restores clarity and spiritual strength.

No power of witchcraft can operate over my life because I belong to Christ.

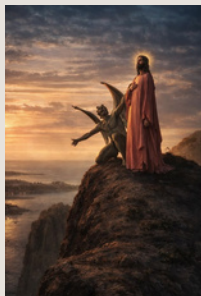
PRAYER

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OVERCOMING DEPRESSION, STRESS, AND ANXIETY

Depression, stress, and anxiety are some of the most subtle yet powerful attacks against the believer. They often begin in the mind and slowly affect the spirit, weakening faith, draining strength, and distorting perspective. While there are natural factors that contribute to these struggles, the enemy also uses them to create heaviness, discouragement, and distance from God. However, God has given the believer peace that is not dependent on circumstances. Victory begins when the mind is aligned with God's truth and the heart learns to trust Him fully.



ISAIAH 26:3

"You will keep in perfect peace those whose minds are steadfast, because they trust in you."

Understanding Overcoming Depression, Stress, and Anxiety

1. The Mind is a Primary Battleground

Many attacks begin in the mind. Kenneth Hagin taught that "wrong thinking produces wrong believing." When the mind is filled with fear, doubt, and negativity, the spirit becomes weighed down. This is why the believer must guard their thoughts carefully.

2. God's Peace is Greater Than Any Pressure

God does not promise a life without challenges, but He promises peace in the midst of them. Watchman Nee explained that "true peace flows from the spirit, not from outward conditions." When the spirit is anchored in God, external pressure loses its control.

3. The Word of God Renews the Mind

The Word is the believer's weapon against mental oppression. Charles G. Finney taught that truth has the power to break emotional bondage. When Scripture fills your mind, lies begin to lose their influence.

4. Prayer Releases Burdens from the Heart

Anxiety grows when burdens are carried alone. Dr Yonggi Cho taught that "prayer transfers burdens from the believer to God." Speaking to God honestly and consistently releases pressure and restores peace.

5. Joy Strengthens the Inner Man

Joy is not just an emotion. It is spiritual strength. Jack Coe's revival environment often emphasised joy as a force that breaks heaviness. When joy is cultivated through gratitude and worship, depression begins to weaken.



CLOSING PRAYER

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DEMONS THAT REPEAT PATTERNS FROM THE BLOODLINE

There are patterns in some families that seem to repeat across generations — cycles of failure, addiction, broken relationships, poverty, or spiritual weakness. While not every pattern is spiritual in nature, some are influenced by generational strongholds. The believer must understand that in Christ, these patterns can be broken. The power of the cross is greater than any inherited limitation.

Understanding Repeating Patterns from the Bloodline

1. Patterns Can Exist Across Generations

Certain struggles can repeat in families. Kenneth Hagin taught that “spiritual patterns can be passed through influence, environment, and in some cases, spiritual bondage.” Awareness is the first step to breaking them.

2. Christ Has Broken the Power of the Past

The believer is no longer bound by their past. Watchman Nee explained that “in Christ, the old man has been crucified.” This means generational influence does not have final authority.

3. The Enemy Uses Patterns to Limit Believers

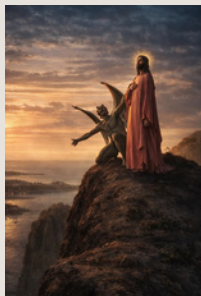

It is not enough to break a pattern. A new one must replace it. Jack Coe’s ministry showed that transformation requires both deliverance and rebuilding. God establishes new patterns of righteousness, peace, and success.

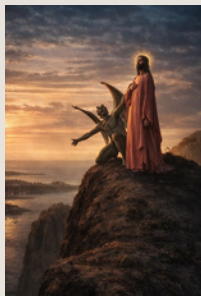
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KNOWING WHO YOU ARE WHEN DEALING WITH SATAN

One of the greatest weapons the enemy uses against believers is identity confusion. When a believer does not understand who they are in Christ, they become vulnerable to fear, intimidation, and defeat. Satan does not primarily attack your possessions or circumstances first—he attacks your understanding. If he can make you doubt your authority, he can limit your effectiveness. But when a believer knows who they are, they stand boldly, resist the enemy, and walk in victory.



LUKE 10:19

Understanding Your Identity When Dealing with Satan

1. Your Authority Comes from Christ, Not Yourself

Your power over the enemy is not based on your personal strength, but on what Christ has accomplished. Pastor Chris Oyakhilome teaches that "you function from a place of authority because you are in Christ, not because of your effort." This means you do not approach spiritual battles begging for victory—you enforce the victory already given.

2. You Are Seated in a Position of Dominion

Scripture teaches that believers are seated with Christ in heavenly places. Maria Woodworth-Etter, known for her powerful ministry, demonstrated that when a believer understands their spiritual position, they operate with unusual boldness. You are not beneath the enemy—you are above him in Christ.

3. Fear is a Sign of Forgotten Identity

Fear often enters when identity is unclear. Prophet Uebert Angel teaches that "fear is a sign that something has challenged your revelation." When you truly know who you are, fear loses its grip. The believer must reject intimidation and stand in confidence.

4. The Word of God Defines Who You Are

Your identity is not based on feelings or experiences. It is defined by the Word. Prophet Emmanuel Makandiwa often emphasises that "what God says about you must become your reality." When the Word fills your heart, it becomes your reference point in every battle.

5. Confidence in Identity Produces Victory

Smith Wigglesworth walked in bold authority because he refused to see himself as weak. He believed what God said about him. When a believer stands firm in identity, the enemy cannot easily manipulate or overpower them. Victory flows from revelation.

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WHAT TO DO WHEN YOU KEEP FAILING REPEATEDLY

Repeated failure can discourage even strong believers. When a person finds themselves falling into the same struggles again and again, it can feel like progress is impossible. However, God does not define you by your failures. He defines you by your position in Christ. The key is not to remain down, but to rise, learn, and grow stronger.

Understanding Repeated Failure

1. Failure is Not Your Identity

Failing does not mean you are a failure. Pastor Chris Oyakhilome teaches that “your identity is rooted in Christ, not your mistakes.” The believer must separate who they are from what they have done.

2. Repeated Failure Often Reveals a Root Issue

Sometimes failure continues because the root has not been

addressed. Aimee Semple McPherson emphasised that spiritual victory requires dealing with underlying issues, not just surface behaviour.

3. The Holy Spirit Empowers Change

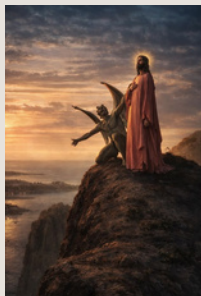

5. Grace Lifts You Up Again

God’s grace is not permission to remain in failure, but power to rise again. Kathryn Kuhlman often emphasised the mercy of God in restoring believers. You are not abandoned—you are being strengthened.

2. Faith Must Be Built Intentionally

Faith does not grow automatically. Smith Wigglesworth built strong faith through constant exposure to the Word. What you feed on determines your strength.

3. The Word is the Source of Faith

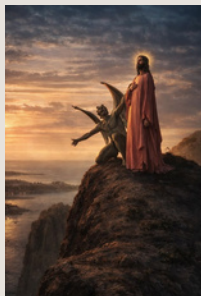
Romans teaches that faith comes by hearing the Word. Prophet Uebert Angel emphasises that "the Word creates the environment for faith to grow."

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HOW TO COMBAT NIGHTMARES

Nightmares are one of the most common spiritual battles that many believers face, yet few understand how to deal with them correctly. While not every nightmare is demonic in origin, some dreams can be influenced by fear, stress, unresolved emotional issues, or even spiritual oppression. The believer must learn to respond biblically rather than living in fear.

Many Christians become terrified after experiencing repeated nightmares involving death, pursuit, snakes, water, darkness, spiritual spouses, attacks, or mysterious figures. The enemy often uses fear to gain influence over a person's thoughts and emotions. However, the child of God must remember that Jesus Christ has already given us authority over all the power of the enemy (Luke 10:19).

Understanding Nightmares and Spiritual Attacks

1. Not Every Dream Comes from God

Many believers assume every dream carries a prophetic meaning. While God does speak through dreams, not every dream is divine. Dreams can originate from:

- * Daily thoughts and concerns
- * Emotional stress
- * Physical conditions
- * Spiritual influences

Wisdom and discernment are necessary before assigning spiritual significance to every dream.

2. Fear is Often the Enemy's Main Objective

The devil understands that a fearful believer is easier to manipulate than a confident believer. Kenneth Hagin often taught that fear is the opposite of faith. Just as faith opens doors for God's operation, fear can create unnecessary spiritual vulnerability. The objective of many nightmares is not the dream itself—it is the fear that follows after waking up.

3. Fill Your Mind with God's Word Before Sleeping

What enters your mind before bed often affects your spiritual atmosphere. Many people spend hours consuming violent movies, social media negativity, occult-themed entertainment, or worldly content before sleeping and then wonder why their dream life becomes troubled. Watchman Nee taught that the spirit of a believer becomes stronger when nourished by God's Word. Reading Scripture and praying before bed creates spiritual stability.

4. Speak God's Authority Over Your Night Season

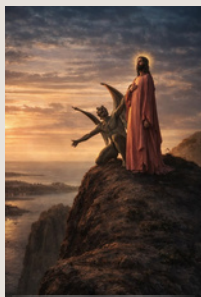
The believer has authority in Christ. You do not need to spend your life fearing every dream. Declare:

- * Psalm 91 over your life
- * The Blood of Jesus over your household
- * God's protection over your sleep

5. Maintain a Strong Prayer Life

Many spiritual attacks lose their power when believers maintain a consistent prayer life. A spiritually weak Christian often becomes more vulnerable to fear and oppression. Prayer builds spiritual strength and confidence. Lessons from Revival History:

John G. Lake frequently taught believers to develop confidence in Christ's authority rather than becoming obsessed with demonic manifestations. He encouraged Christians to become God-conscious rather than devil-conscious. The more conscious you are of Christ's victory, the less power fear will have over your life.

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SIGNS OF WRONG FRIENDS

Relationships play a powerful role in shaping a believer's spiritual life. Many people underestimate how much influence those around them have on their thinking, decisions, and spiritual direction. Wrong friendships do not always appear dangerous at first. Sometimes they seem harmless, enjoyable, or even supportive on the surface. However, over time, they can slowly weaken conviction, distort values, and pull a believer away from God's will. This is why discernment in relationships is essential. The believer must be intentional about who they allow close into their life.

Understanding Signs of Wrong Friends

1. Wrong Friends Gradually Weaken Your Spiritual Conviction

One of the clearest signs of wrong associations is a slow decline in spiritual sensitivity. Pastor Chris Oyakhilometeaches that "anything that reduces your passion for God is a threat to your spiritual life." If you find that your hunger for prayer, the Word, or worship is decreasing because of certain relationships, it is a warning sign. The influence may not be obvious at first, but over time, it affects your inner life.

2. They Normalize What God Calls Wrong

Wrong friends often make compromise seem acceptable. Smith Wigglesworth lived a life of strict devotion and refused influences that weakened his walk with God. When people around you begin to justify sin, mock righteousness, or make light of spiritual things, they create an environment where compromise becomes easier. What you tolerate repeatedly, you eventually accept.

3. They Pull You Away from God's Direction

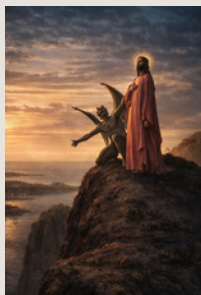
God may lead you one way, but wrong friendships can introduce confusion. Prophet Emmanuel Makandiwa teaches that "not everyone in your life is aligned with your destiny." Some people may not intentionally harm you, but their influence may distract you from your purpose. If a relationship constantly pulls you away from obedience or creates inner conflict, it must be evaluated carefully.

4. They Create Pressure to Conform

Wrong associations often bring subtle pressure to fit in. Maria Woodworth-Etter's ministry showed that those who stood firm in God often had to separate from certain influences. If you feel pressured to compromise your values, speak differently, act differently, or hide your faith, that environment is not spiritually healthy. God calls you to stand, not to blend into compromise.

5. They Do Not Strengthen Your Walk with God

True friendships build you spiritually. Prophet Uebert Angel teaches that "the right people will push you closer to God, not away from Him." If a relationship does not encourage growth, correction, accountability, or spiritual progress, it is not beneficial for your walk. Relationships should add strength, not remove it.

Many believers struggle not because they lack desire for God, but because they do not guard what surrounds them. A polluted environment can weaken even a sincere believer, while a godly environment strengthens and builds the inner man.

Understanding Guarding Your Spiritual Environment

1. What You Allow In Determines What Grows Within

Everything that enters your life has an effect. Pastor Chris Oyakhilome teaches that “your spirit feeds on what you consistently expose yourself to.” If your environment is filled with negativity, compromise, and worldly influence, it will affect your thinking and behaviour. But if it is filled with the Word, worship, and godly influence, it strengthens your spirit.

2. Atmosphere Influences Spiritual Sensitivity

Spiritual environments carry influence. Kathryn Kuhlman’s meetings were known for strong atmospheres of God’s presence because of intentional focus

on the Holy Spirit. Likewise, environments filled with confusion, fear, or sin can dull spiritual sensitivity. The believer must be aware that atmosphere matters.

3. You Must Guard Your Heart Intentionally

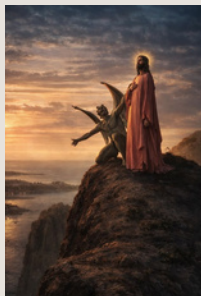
Scripture says “above all else, guard your heart.” This means it requires effort and awareness. Prophet Emmanuel Makandiwa teaches that “not everything deserves access to your spirit.” You must be selective about what you listen to, watch, and engage with. Guarding your heart is not isolation—it is protection.

4. Creating a Godly Environment Strengthens You

A believer should not only avoid negative environments but also create positive ones. Dr Yonggi Cho emphasised that “a life filled with prayer, worship, and the Word creates a spiritual atmosphere of growth.” Your personal space, your daily habits, and your routine should reflect your desire to grow spiritually.

5. Consistency in the Right Environment Produces Transformation

Transformation does not happen instantly. It is the result of consistent exposure to the right environment. John G. Lake’s life showed that sustained time in God’s presence produces spiritual authority. When your environment consistently aligns with God, your life begins to reflect His nature.

3. Covering Through Prayer is Essential

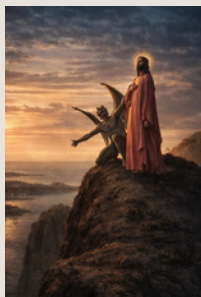

3. Dependence Must Remain on the Holy Spirit

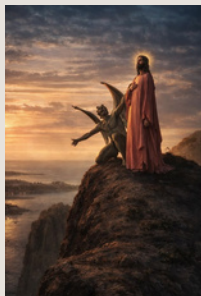

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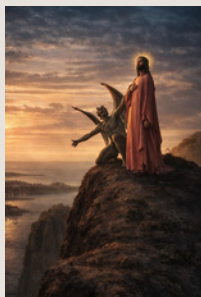
PHONE ADDICTION AND HOW TO OVERCOME IT

In today's world, the phone has become one of the most powerful tools in daily life. While it can be used for good, it can also become a source of distraction, control, and spiritual weakness when misused. Phone addiction is not just about time—it is about attention, discipline, and influence. When a believer becomes controlled by their device, their spiritual focus begins to weaken. Prayer time reduces, attention becomes scattered, and sensitivity to the Holy Spirit declines. The issue is not the phone itself, but what it is allowed to control in your life.

Understanding Phone Addiction and How to Overcome It

1. Anything That Controls You Becomes a Master

Paul makes it clear that we must not be mastered by anything. Pastor Chris Oyakhilome teaches that “you were called to dominate, not to be dominated.” When your phone dictates your time, attention, and focus, it begins to take a position it was never meant to have. The believer must remain in control, not controlled.



1 CORINTHIANS 6:12

2. Constant Distraction Weakens Spiritual Sensitivity

The content you view affects your inner life. Prophet Uebert Angel teaches that “what you expose yourself to consistently becomes your reality.” If your phone is filled with ungodly, negative, or distracting content, it will influence your thinking and behaviour.

Freedom requires discipline. John G. Lake's life demonstrated that spiritual authority flows from disciplined living. Setting limits, reducing unnecessary usage, and creating structured time for God are necessary steps toward regaining control.

It is not enough to remove something—you must replace it. Dr Yonggi Cho taught that “spiritual habits must be cultivated intentionally.” Time that was previously wasted can be redirected toward prayer, the Word, and growth. This creates lasting change.

Many believers struggle silently, but God offers freedom, restoration, and transformation through His Spirit.

Understanding Defeating Pornographic Addiction

1. Lust Begins in the Mind Before It Becomes Action

Jesus makes it clear that the battle begins internally. Charles G. Finney taught that “sin must be addressed at its root, not just its expression.” What enters your mind repeatedly eventually influences your actions.

2. Addiction Creates Spiritual Weakness

Pornography weakens spiritual sensitivity. Kathryn Kuhlman emphasised purity as essential for the presence of God. When the mind is polluted, it becomes harder to focus, pray, and grow spiritually.

3. The Holy Spirit Empowers Freedom

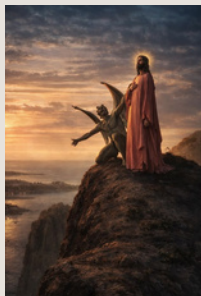

God's desire is not condemnation but freedom. True victory comes when the believer understands the root of the struggle and allows the Holy Spirit to bring transformation from within.

Understanding Defeating Masturbation

1. The Body is Meant to be Governed by the Spirit

Paul reminds us that the body is the temple of the Holy Spirit. This means it is not meant to be controlled by impulses or desires. Pastor Chris Oyakhilome teaches that "the recreated human spirit must dominate the body." When the spirit is weak, the body takes control. But when the spirit is strengthened, discipline becomes possible.

2. This Struggle is Often Fueled by Thoughts and Exposure

What feeds the mind eventually influences behaviour. Watchman Nee explained that "the battle of the flesh is first won or lost in the realm of thought." Exposure to sexual content, suggestive media, or repeated imagination creates a pattern that leads to action. Cutting off these inputs is essential.

3. Temporary Relief Leads to Long-Term Weakness

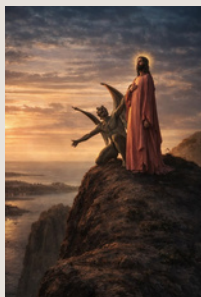
The act may provide temporary satisfaction, but it weakens the inner man. Kathryn Kuhlman emphasised that purity is necessary for a strong spiritual life. Repeated indulgence dulls sensitivity to the Holy Spirit and creates cycles that are difficult to break without intervention.

Self-control is not achieved by willpower alone. Prophet Emmanuel Makandiwa teaches that "the Spirit empowers you to overcome what the flesh cannot control." As you yield to the Holy Spirit, strength increases, and the hold of the habit begins to break.

The enemy understands that finances affect stability, peace, and progress, so he often targets this area. However, the believer must remember that God is the source, and no attack can override His provision when the believer walks in alignment with Him.

Understanding Financial Attacks and How to Overcome Them

1. God is the Source, Not the System

Your provision does not come from your job, business, or environment—it comes from God. Pastor Chris Oyakhilome teaches that “your source is divine, not earthly.” When you understand this, fear begins to lose its hold, because your dependence shifts from systems to God.

2. The Enemy Uses Pressure to Create Fear and Instability

Financial attacks often come with pressure, urgency, and anxiety. Oral Roberts, known for his teachings on divine provision, emphasised that fear blocks faith. The enemy wants you to panic, because panic weakens your ability to trust God and make wise decisions.

3. Stewardship Must Be Examined Honestly

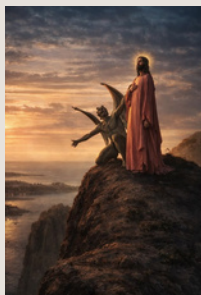

3. Obedience Unlocks Progress

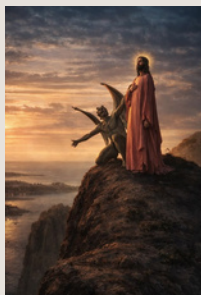

3. Greed Produces Restlessness and Discontentment

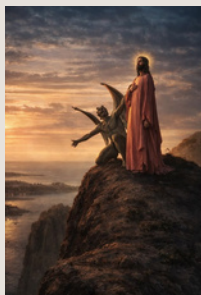

3. Consistent Habits Build Strong Character

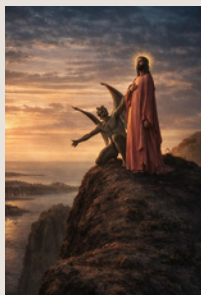

3. Prayerlessness Leads to Spiritual Weakness

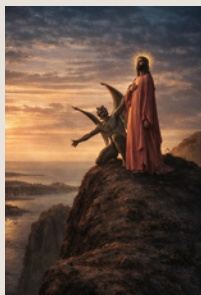

3. Comfort Can Become an Enemy of Progress

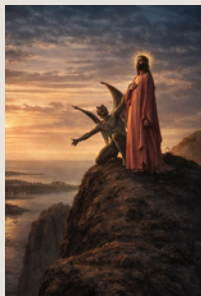

Understanding How to Deal with Spiritual Oppression

1. Your Identity in Christ Cancels Every False Claim

The most important truth is that you belong to Christ. 3. Prayer and the Word Establish Spiritual Authority

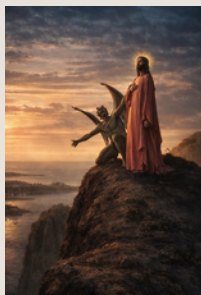

3. The Word of God Carries Enforcing Power

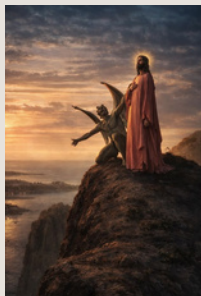

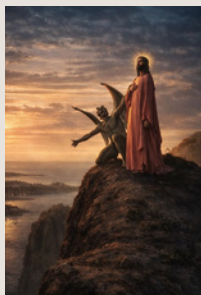

Heavenly Father, thank You that Your power is at work in me. Help me to walk in boldness and confidence. In Jesus' name, I pray. Amen.

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THE DEMONIC LAWS THAT DEMONS USE AGAINST IGNORANT CHRISTIANS

Spiritual battles are not random. The enemy often operates through principles—taking advantage of ignorance, fear, disobedience, and agreement. Many believers suffer not because God has abandoned them, but because they are unaware of how spiritual realities work. Understanding truth closes doors that ignorance leaves open.

Understanding How Demons Gain Advantage

1. Ignorance Creates Vulnerability

Pastor Chris teaches that “knowledge is protection.” Without understanding, believers may unknowingly allow access.

2. Disobedience Opens Doors

Charles G. Finney emphasised that disobedience weakens spiritual authority. Alignment with God protects the believer.

3. Words Create Agreements

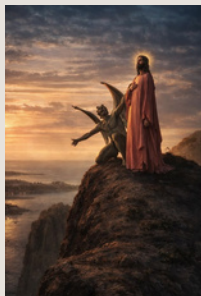
What you speak matters. John G. Lake taught that words release spiritual forces. Negative words can reinforce attacks.

4. Fear Strengthens the Enemy's Influence

Fear is agreement with the enemy. Reinhard Bonnke preached that fear must be rejected for faith to operate.

5. Truth Breaks Every Strategy of Darkness

Once truth is known, freedom begins. The Word dismantles deception.

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SATAN USES YOUR POWER AS A CHRISTIAN AGAINST YOU

Many Christians assume that Satan's greatest advantage is his power, but Scripture teaches otherwise. The devil is not greater than God, nor does he possess authority over a believer who is walking in Christ. His greatest weapon is deception. He often takes the power, authority, gifts, words, and blessings that God has given to believers and attempts to use them against them through ignorance and spiritual immaturity.

Understanding How Satan Uses a Christian's Power Against Them

1. Satan Uses Your Words Against You

Many believers unknowingly speak defeat over their lives by constantly confessing failure, sickness, fear, and limitation. The enemy cannot force words into your mouth, but he will gladly use negative confessions to strengthen unbelief and discouragement. Pastor Chris Oyakhilome often teaches that words shape the course of a person's life. Speak God's promises more than your problems.

2. Satan Uses Fear Against You

Fear is misplaced faith. While faith expects God's goodness, fear expects disaster. The enemy often plants fearful thoughts concerning finances, health, family, and the future. If those thoughts are entertained long enough, they begin to influence decisions and weaken faith. Dr. David Yonggi Cho taught believers to fill their imagination with God's promises rather than worst-case scenarios.

3. Satan Uses Ignorance Against Believers

A believer who does not understand his identity, authority, and covenant rights can easily be manipulated. Watchman Nee taught that many Christians live below their inheritance simply because they do not know what belongs to them in Christ. Knowledge of God's Word is one of the greatest forms of spiritual protection.

4. Satan Uses Wrong Relationships

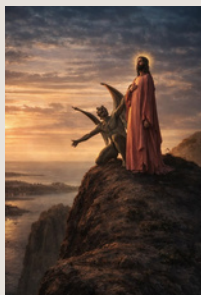
Not every person in your life is helping you grow spiritually. Wrong relationships can weaken conviction, reduce spiritual passion, and lead believers into compromise. The enemy often uses ungodly influences to pull believers away from God's purpose. Protect your spiritual environment carefully.

5. Satan Uses Your Blessings Against You

One of Satan's most subtle strategies is to use success to create complacency. As blessings increase, prayer can decrease, pride can grow, and dependence upon God can weaken. King Uzziah remained strong until success led him into pride. Never allow God's blessings to replace your need for God.

6. Satan Uses Your Mind Against You

The battlefield of spiritual warfare is often the mind. Negative thoughts, anxiety, condemnation, and doubt are some of the enemy's favourite tools. Prophet Uebert Angel frequently teaches that many victories or defeats begin in the mind before they appear anywhere else. Guard your thoughts with the Word of God. Smith Wigglesworth once said: "The devil knows if he can capture your thought life, he can influence your actions." The enemy is not primarily looking for powerless Christians. He is looking for ignorant Christians. A believer who understands God's Word, knows his identity in Christ, and walks in faith becomes extremely difficult to deceive.

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WORK ON UNDERSTANDING YOUR IDENTITY IN CHRIST

One of the greatest weaknesses in the life of a believer is a lack of understanding of their identity in Christ. Many people are born again but still think, speak, and live as though they are bound, weak, or defeated. This creates a contradiction between what God has done and what the believer experiences. Identity is not a small doctrine—it is the foundation of authority, confidence, and spiritual victory. Until a believer understands who they are, they will struggle to walk in what they have been given.

Understanding Your Identity in Christ

1. You Are a New Creation, Not an Improved Old One

When you are born again, you are not simply a better version of your old self—you are made new. Pastor Chris Oyakhilome teaches that “Christianity is not reformation, it is recreation.” This means your past does not define you. Your identity is rooted in what Christ has done, not in what you have been through.

2. Identity Determines Authority

A believer who does not understand their identity cannot operate in authority. Reinhard Bonnke often emphasised that believers must see themselves as God sees them. When identity is weak, fear grows. When identity is strong, authority becomes natural.

3. The Word of God Reveals Who You Truly Are

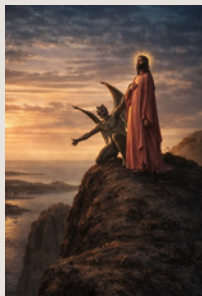
You do not discover your identity through feelings—you discover it through the Word. Smith Wigglesworth refused to base his life on emotions and relied fully on Scripture. As you study the Word, your identity becomes clearer, and your confidence increases.

4. Wrong Identity Leads to Wrong Living

If you see yourself as weak, you will act weak. If you see yourself as defeated, you will live defeated. Prophet Emmanuel Makandiwa teaches that “your perception of yourself determines your manifestation.” Identity shapes behaviour.

5. Living from Identity Produces Consistent Victory

When identity is understood, life changes. You stop reacting from fear and begin responding from authority. You stop begging for victory and start enforcing it. A believer grounded in identity walks with confidence, clarity, and stability.

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REBUKE NEGATIVE WORDS

Words are not empty. They carry power, direction, and influence. Many believers unknowingly speak against themselves by agreeing with fear, doubt, and negativity. The enemy often uses a believer's own words to reinforce defeat. This is why it is essential not only to speak correctly but also to actively reject and rebuke negative words. What you allow to remain spoken over your life can shape your reality.

Understanding Rebuking Negative Words

1. Words Carry Creative Power

God created through words, and believers, made in His image, also speak with power. Pastor Chris teaches that "your words are containers of power." What you say consistently will influence your life.

2. Negative Words Create Agreement with Defeat

When you speak negatively, you align with what you do not want. John G. Lake emphasised that agreement determines spiritual outcome. Speaking defeat reinforces defeat.

3. You Must Reject Wrong Words Immediately

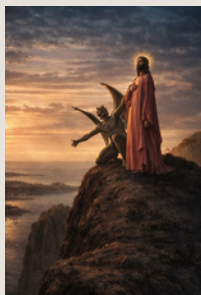
Do not allow negative words to remain unchallenged. Prophet Uebert Angel teaches that "what you do not correct, you permit." Rebuking negative words means actively rejecting them and replacing them with truth.

4. Speak in Alignment with God's Word

The believer must learn to speak what God says. Smith Wigglesworth only spoke what aligned with Scripture, refusing to confess anything else.

5. Consistency in Speech Produces Results

One confession is not enough. Consistent, faith-filled speech shapes outcomes over time. What you repeatedly declare becomes established.

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HOW YOUR OFFERINGS CAN DEFEAT DEVILS

Many believers see giving only from a natural perspective, but it carries spiritual implications. When done in faith and obedience, offerings can shift atmospheres, break resistance, and align the believer with God's provision.

Understanding How Offerings Defeat Resistance

1. Giving is a Spiritual Act, Not Just Financial

Offerings reflect the condition of the heart. Oral Roberts taught that "giving is a point of contact for faith." It connects the believer to God's promises.

2. Offerings Align You with God's Covenant

When you give, you demonstrate trust in God as your source.

Pastor Chris teaches that "giving positions you in the flow of divine provision." It shifts your reliance from self to God.

3. Generosity Breaks Spiritual Resistance

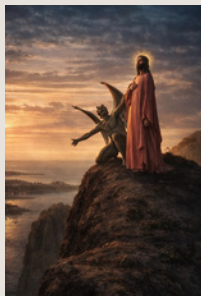
Greed and fear can create barriers. Giving breaks those barriers. Prophet Uebert Angel emphasises that giving can unlock doors that seem closed.

4. Pray for Their Purpose

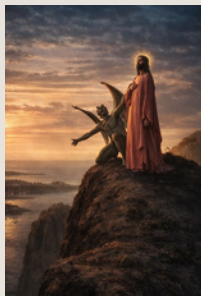
Every believer has a calling. A spouse who fulfills their purpose becomes a blessing to the entire family. Pray for:

One of the biggest mistakes believers make in spiritual warfare is becoming more conscious of demons than they are of Jesus Christ. While spiritual warfare is real, the Christian life is not supposed to revolve around fear of the devil. It is supposed to revolve around faith in Christ.

Some believers see demons behind every problem, every inconvenience, every setback, and every disagreement. They spend more time studying darkness than studying God's Word. This creates fear, confusion, and spiritual imbalance.

Understanding Proper Spiritual Balance

1. Jesus Must Be Bigger Than the Devil in Your Mind

The devil is a created being. Jesus is Lord. When believers become obsessed with demonic activity, they unintentionally magnify the enemy instead of magnifying Christ.

2. Spiritual Awareness is Necessary, Obsession is Dangerous

The Bible teaches believers to be vigilant, but it does not teach believers to become obsessed with darkness. There is a difference between discernment and paranoia.

3. Focus on God's Power More Than Satan's Activity

Charles Finney observed that revival flourishes when people become conscious of God's presence rather than becoming fascinated by demonic manifestations. The Holy Spirit should occupy more of your attention than the devil.

4. Christ Has Already Won the Victory

Many Christians fight as though victory still needs to be achieved. The Cross settled the ultimate outcome. Believers do not fight for victory. Believers fight from victory.

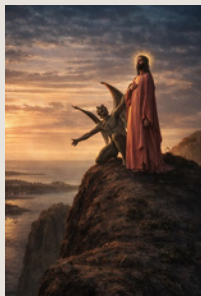
5. Fill Your Mind with God's Word

The strongest believers are usually not those who constantly talk about demons. They are those who constantly meditate on:

- * God's promises
- * Christ's victory
- * The Holy Spirit's guidance
- * Kingdom purpose

Lessons from Kenneth Hagin:

Kenneth Hagin often warned believers against excessive demon-consciousness. He taught that many Christians give the devil more attention than he deserves. His advice was simple: *"Keep your eyes on Jesus and walk in the light of God's Word."*
