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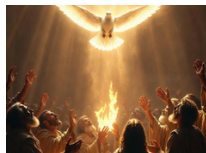
MONTH OF SPIRITUAL REVIVAL

Understanding Spiritual Revival

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HOW TO ATTRACT SPIRITUAL REVIVAL

JAMES 4:8

"Come near to God and He will come near to you."



Revival is not something that happens randomly. It is something that is attracted. Throughout history, every genuine move of God has been preceded by people who positioned themselves through hunger, prayer, and surrender. God does not force revival upon people—He responds to those who desire Him deeply. If you want revival, you must create the conditions that attract His presence.



Understanding How to Attract Revival

1. Hunger is the Foundation of Revival

Revival begins with desire. Reinhard Bonnke often said, “the gospel is only good news if it gets there in time,” and this urgency was driven by hunger for God and souls. Pastor Chris Oyakhilome teaches that “God moves where He is wanted.” A casual heart cannot sustain revival—only hunger can.

2. Prayer Prepares the Atmosphere

Every revival in history has been birthed in prayer. John Knox’s intense prayer life shook Scotland. Dr YonggiCho teaches that “prayer is the key that unlocks the move of God.” When prayer increases, spiritual activity increases.

3. Holiness Sustains the Move of God

God does not dwell in compromise. Kathryn Kuhlman emphasised that purity is essential for hosting God’s presence. Revival cannot continue where sin is tolerated.

4. Consistency Builds Spiritual Momentum

Revival is not built in a moment—it is sustained through consistency. Smith Wigglesworth maintained a disciplined spiritual life, which allowed him to walk in continuous power.

5. Expectation Draws Manifestation

Faith expects God to move. Prophet Uebert Angel teaches that “expectation is the breeding ground for miracles.” When you expect revival, you position yourself to receive it.

JAMES 5:16

"The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective."



John Knox was not known for gentle prayers—he was known for desperate, passionate, and powerful intercession. His famous cry, “Give me Scotland or I die,” was not emotional exaggeration—it was a reflection of deep burden and spiritual urgency. His prayers were so impactful that even rulers feared his intercession. This shows that prayer, when done with sincerity and intensity, carries power to influence nations.



Understanding Revival Prayer

1. Prayer Must Come from Deep Burden

John Knox did not pray casually—he prayed with urgency. True revival prayer is not routine; it is driven by a deep desire to see God move.

2. Prayer Carries Authority When Aligned with God's Will

Pastor Chris teaches that “effective prayer is prayer aligned with God's Word.” Knox's prayers were powerful because they were rooted in God's purpose.

3. Persistence is Essential in Prayer

Revival does not come through one prayer. It comes through consistent intercession. Charles Finney emphasised persistent prayer as the key to revival.

4. Prayer Must Be Sacrificial

LEARN SOUL WINNING FROM THE GREAT BILLY GRAHAM PART 1

PROVERBS 11:30

"The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life, and he who wins souls is wise."



Soul winning is one of the clearest expressions of the heart of God. Throughout Scripture, we see God reaching for men and women who are lost, broken, and far from Him. Billy Graham's life stands as one of the greatest modern examples of this burden. He did not build his ministry around entertainment, trends, or personal fame. He built it around one clear mission: preach Christ and call people to salvation. This is a lesson every believer must learn. Soul winning is not only for evangelists on a platform. It is part of the calling of every Christian. If you are in Christ, then you have been entrusted with a message that can change eternity for someone else.



Understanding Soul Winning Through the Example of Billy Graham

1. Soul Winning Must Remain Focused on Christ

Billy Graham's message was powerful because it was centred on Jesus Christ. He did not rely on complicated philosophy or human cleverness. The believer must not wait until they feel perfect before evangelising. If you know Christ, you already carry a message worth sharing.

3. Compassion is Essential in Winning Souls

Soul winning is not about trying to prove spirituality. It is about loving people enough to tell them the truth that can save them.

4. Consistency Builds Greater Impact Over Time

Billy Graham did not influence nations in one day. He remained faithful over many years. This teaches us that soul winning is not just about one event. It is a lifestyle of consistency. Smith Wigglesworth's life also reflected consistency in spiritual things. A believer who stays available to God, remains prayerful, and continues to preach Christ will produce fruit over time. Do not underestimate the power of faithful witness.

5. Every Soul Has Eternal Value

One of the reasons soul winning is so important is because every person carries eternal worth. A soul is not cheap in the sight of God. Billy Graham understood that behind every crowd were individuals whose eternal destiny was at stake. 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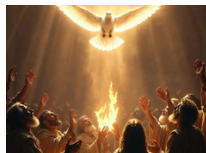
PRAY FOR HUNGER TO CAUSE IMPACT

PROVERBS 11:30

"The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life, and he who wins souls is wise."



Spiritual impact does not begin with talent, ambition, or visibility. It begins with hunger. Hunger is what drives a man to seek God beyond routine. Hunger is what makes a believer refuse a dry, powerless Christian life. Many people want impact, but they do not want the hunger that produces it. Every genuine move of God in history has been carried by men and women who wanted Him more than comfort, more than approval, and more than routine religion. If you want your life to carry influence in the spirit, then you must pray for hunger.



Understanding Hunger That Produces Impact

1. Hunger is the Doorway to Spiritual Depth

A hungry heart does not settle for surface-level Christianity. It pushes deeper into prayer, the Word, and fellowship with God. John Knox's desperate prayer life was fueled by holy hunger. He was not satisfied with religious activity. He wanted God to move in his nation. Pastor Chris teaches that "the measure of your desire for God affects the level of His operation in your life." If you want impact, you must first cultivate appetite for more of God.

2. Hunger Pushes You Beyond Comfort

Comfort is one of the enemies of revival and impact. A hungry believer cannot remain satisfied with spiritual passivity. Reinhard Bonnke burned with hunger for souls and revival, and this hunger pushed him into massive gospel campaigns. Hunger makes a believer rise early to pray, stay longer in the Word, and become more intentional in obedience. When hunger is present, excuses begin to lose their power.

3. Hunger Attracts God's Presence

God responds to those who sincerely seek Him. Scripture says that if we draw near to God, He will draw near to us. Prophet Uebert Angel teaches that "where desire is real, visitation becomes possible." Hunger invites divine encounter because it expresses value. When you hunger for God, you are telling Him that His presence matters more to you than anything else.

4. Hunger Creates Burden and Vision

A spiritually hungry person does not only want personal blessing. They begin to desire impact. They want to see souls saved, lives changed, and territories touched by God. Charles Finney's burden for awakening was born out of deep spiritual desire. Hunger changes the focus of the believer from self-preservation to kingdom influence. It enlarges your heart for what matters to God.

5. Hunger Must Be Prayed For and Protected

Sometimes believers lose hunger through distraction, compromise, or routine. That is why hunger must be prayed for continually. Dr Yonggi Cho emphasised that spiritual fire must be maintained intentionally. The things that feed hunger must be embraced, and the things that quench it must be removed. Prayer, worship, Scripture, and obedience protect hunger. If hunger is preserved, impact will follow.

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BURDEN FOR SOULS

ROMANS 9:1-3

"I have great sorrow and unceasing anguish in my heart... for the sake of my people..."



A burden for souls is one of the clearest signs that a believer has begun to align with the heart of God. Many Christians want blessing, favour, and breakthrough, but revival becomes real when the heart begins to carry what God carries. Souls matter deeply to God. Heaven rejoices over one sinner who repents. This means a believer who walks closely with God will eventually begin to feel the weight of lost people around them. A burden for souls is not mere emotion. It is a spiritual burden that produces prayer, compassion, urgency, and action.



Understanding the Burden for Souls

1. A Burden for Souls Reflects the Heart of God

God is deeply concerned about the lost. Billy Graham preached with such urgency because he understood eternity. His burden was not for large meetings alone, but for people to be saved. Pastor Chris teaches that "when you receive God's thoughts, you begin to care about what He cares about." A burden for souls shows that the believer is becoming more aligned with heaven's priorities

2. Burden Produces Prayerful Intercession

A person with a true burden for souls does not only see sin; they see the need for salvation. Reinhard Bonnke did not merely condemn sinners; he ran toward them with the gospel. Prophet Emmanuel Makandiwa often stresses the importance of seeing people through the lens of redemption. Burden softens the heart. It helps the believer respond with compassion rather than pride.

4. Burden Leads to Evangelistic Action

A burden that never moves you to action is incomplete. The reason many revivalists impacted their generation is because they did not only feel something — they did something. Billy Graham preached. Bonnke traveled. Knox prayed. Finney called people to repentance. A burden for souls should move you to witness, invite, speak, pray, and make room for the gospel to spread through your life.

5. Burden Must Be Sustained Through Fellowship with God

A soul burden is not sustained by emotion alone. It is maintained in God's presence. If a believer becomes disconnected from prayer and the Word, their burden for souls can begin to fade. Dr Yonggi Cho taught that prayer keeps kingdom priorities alive in the heart. To carry a burden for souls, you must stay close to the One who gave His Son for them.

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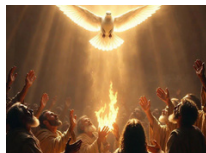

STEPS TO INCREASE YOUR SOUL WINNING POTENTIAL

MATTHEW 28:19

"Therefore go and make disciples of all nations..."

Soul winning is not only a calling, it is also a skill that grows with spiritual maturity, preparation, and practice. Many believers desire to evangelise but feel unprepared, uncertain, or ineffective. The good news is that soul winning potential can be increased. God can make you more effective in reaching people if you are willing to grow. Evangelism becomes stronger when the believer combines love, knowledge, boldness, prayer, and sensitivity to the Holy Spirit.



Understanding How to Increase Your Soul Winning Potential

1. Increase Your Knowledge of the Gospel

A believer must know the message they are carrying. Billy Graham was effective because he knew the gospel clearly and preached it consistently. Pastor Chris teaches that "clarity produces confidence." When you understand salvation, grace, repentance, and the work of Christ, you become more effective in explaining it to others. A confused witness produces little impact, but a clear witness carries power.

2. Grow in Boldness Through Prayer

3. Develop Sensitivity to the Holy Spirit

Effective soul winning is not only about speaking more. It is also about hearing God more. The Holy Spirit knows who is ready, what to say, and how to say it. Reinhard Bonnke depended heavily on the Spirit's leading in evangelism. Prophet Uebert Angel teaches that discernment helps you know when hearts are open. A believer who listens to the Spirit becomes more fruitful in evangelism.

4. Practice Consistently and Intentionally

Soul winning grows with use. If you never practice, you will remain hesitant. Smith Wigglesworth was a man of action. He believed faith must move. In the same way, evangelism must be exercised. Start with conversations, invitations, encouragement, testimony, and clear gospel sharing. As you practice, your confidence and effectiveness increase.

5. Carry Genuine Love for People

Technique without love becomes empty. Soul winning must come from a sincere desire to see people saved. Billy Graham's message was powerful because it was carried by conviction and compassion. When people sense that you truly care, they become more open. Love is one of the greatest forces in evangelism because it reflects the nature of God Himself.

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DO NOT BE AFRAID TO EVANGELISE

ROMANS 1:16

"For I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God that brings salvation..."

Fear is one of the greatest enemies of evangelism. Many believers know the gospel is true, yet they hesitate to share it because of fear of rejection, fear of embarrassment, fear of not knowing enough, or fear of people's opinions. The enemy uses fear to silence voices that could bring life to others. But the gospel was never meant to be hidden. It carries power. The believer must not allow fear to stop what God has commanded.



Understanding How to Overcome Fear in Evangelism

1. Fear of Man Must Be Broken

One of the biggest reasons believers stay silent is because they are too conscious of people. Billy Graham preached before presidents, crowds, and nations because he feared God more than man. Pastor Chris teaches that "you cannot be God-conscious and man-controlled at the same time." If you are more aware of God's commission than people's reactions, fear begins to lose control.

2. The Gospel Carries the Power, Not You

Many people are afraid because they think everything depends on their performance. But the power is in the gospel itself. Reinhard Bonnke often declared that the gospel is not only words but the power of God unto salvation. This means your responsibility is to speak it faithfully. God is the One who convicts and transforms hearts.

3. Boldness Grows Through Use

Boldness is strengthened when exercised. The more you share Christ, the easier it becomes to evangelise again. Smith Wigglesworth did not become bold by waiting for fear to disappear. He acted in faith. Fear often shrinks when obedience rises. Start where you are, and confidence will grow.

4. Souls are More Important Than Your Comfort

A burden for souls helps break fear. If you truly understand that people need salvation, then your discomfort becomes smaller than their need. Prophet Emmanuel Makandiwa teaches that kingdom-mindedness changes personal priorities. When eternity becomes real in your heart, evangelism stops feeling optional.

5. The Holy Spirit Helps You Speak

You are not alone when you evangelise. The Holy Spirit is your helper. He gives utterance, boldness, and wisdom. Dr Yonggi Cho taught that the Spirit empowers believers for witness. As you depend on Him, you will find yourself able to say what you could not have said in your own strength.

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THE AZUSA REVIVAL

ACTS 2:17

"In the last days, God says, I will pour out my Spirit on all people."

The Azusa Street Revival remains one of the most significant revivals in modern church history. It was not built on human prestige, wealth, or polished presentation. It was marked by hunger, humility, repentance, prayer, and the visible operation of the Holy Spirit. Under the leadership of William J. Seymour, God moved in a way that touched nations and reshaped the global Church. Azusa teaches us that revival is not dependent on outward greatness, but on surrender and the presence of God.



Understanding the Azusa Revival

1. Revival Can Begin in Humble Places

Azusa did not begin in a famous cathedral. It began in a simple mission building. This teaches that revival is not about location, status, or appearance. It is about God's presence. William Seymour was not elevated by worldly standards, but he was available to God. Kathryn Kuhlman often said that God is looking not for golden vessels but for yielded vessels. Azusa proves that when God finds surrender, He can send fire.

2. Humility Attracts the Move of God

The people at Azusa were desperate for God, not for human recognition. Seymour's leadership was marked by humility. He often prayed with his head inside a wooden crate, seeking God. This kind of humility created room for God's glory. Pastor Chris teaches that pride resists divine flow, but humility creates room for the Spirit to operate. Revival thrives where flesh is reduced and God is exalted.

3. The Holy Spirit Manifests Freely in Revival

Azusa was marked by prayer, repentance, tongues, healing, and supernatural manifestations. But the deeper lesson is that the Holy Spirit was welcomed and obeyed. Revival is not just emotional intensity. It is divine activity. The Spirit was not quenched. Prophet Uebert Angel teaches that believers must learn to host the Holy Spirit with sensitivity and honour. Where He is allowed to move freely, revival increases.

4. Revival Spreads Beyond the Original Place

One of the most remarkable things about Azusa was its global impact. Missionaries and ministers carried the fire into many nations. This teaches that revival is never meant to stay contained. It spreads through yielded people. Reinhard Bonnke's ministry also reflected this principle — fire carried by one person can touch multitudes. When revival is genuine, it multiplies.

5. Revival Requires Continued Hunger and Prayer

Azusa did not begin with publicity. It began with prayer meetings and seeking. Revival is sustained by the same things that birth it. If prayer declines, hunger fades, and compromise enters, revival weakens. This is why every generation must seek God afresh. Revival cannot be inherited merely by history. It must be pursued in the present.

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THE SUPERNATURAL POWER INSIDE REVIVAL

ACTS 1:8

"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you..."

Revival is not only about increased emotion or larger gatherings. At the heart of true revival is supernatural power. When God revives His people, the Holy Spirit begins to move in ways that convict, heal, deliver, restore, and transform. Revival carries power because it is driven by the Holy Spirit, not by human enthusiasm. This power is not given for display or pride. It is given to glorify Christ, awaken the Church, and reach the lost.



Understanding the Supernatural Power Inside Revival

1. Revival Power Comes from the Holy Spirit

The source of supernatural power is not personality, gifting, or human effort. It is the Holy Spirit. William Seymour understood this during Azusa. The focus was not on men but on the Spirit. Pastor Chris teaches that “without the Holy Ghost, Christianity becomes mere religion.” Revival power is evidence that God Himself is moving among His people.

2. Supernatural Power Brings Conviction and Transformation

True revival power does not only produce signs. It changes hearts. Charles Finney’s meetings were marked by intense conviction because God’s presence was at work. People wept, repented, and turned back to God. This shows that the supernatural is not only about visible miracles. Conviction itself is a miracle of divine power touching the human heart.

3. Power in Revival Releases Healing and Deliverance

Throughout revival history, supernatural healings and deliverances have often accompanied the move of God. John G. Lake, Smith Wigglesworth, and Kathryn Kuhlman all demonstrated this reality in different ways. The point was not to entertain people, but to reveal the dominion of Christ. When revival comes, the power of darkness is challenged, and the life of God becomes visible.

4. Supernatural Power Draws Attention to Christ

Revival power must always point people back to Jesus. Reinhard Bonnke preached Christ crucified and risen, and miracles followed as confirmation. Prophet Emmanuel Makandiwa also stresses that power must glorify God, not men. If power becomes self-centred, it is corrupted. But when power reveals Christ, faith rises and souls are drawn to Him.

5. Believers Must Remain Humble and Yielded to Carry Revival Power

The supernatural cannot be carried safely by pride. William Seymour’s humility allowed God to trust him with extraordinary visitation. Dr Yonggi Cho taught that dependence on the Holy Spirit must remain central. A believer who wants to carry revival power must stay surrendered, prayerful, and hungry. The power belongs to God, and He entrusts it to yielded vessels.

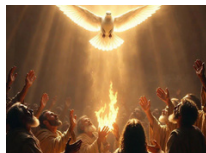
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LEARN TO LOVE YOUR CHRISTIAN NEIGHBOUR

JOHN 13:35

"By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another."

One of the clearest signs of true Christianity is love. Revival is not measured only by prayer meetings, spiritual manifestations, or passionate worship. It is also measured by how believers treat one another. Many people want power, influence, and spiritual experiences, but neglect the simple command to love their Christian neighbour. Yet Jesus made it plain that love is one of the strongest evidences that we belong to Him. A believer who wants to walk in true revival must learn to love fellow believers sincerely, sacrificially, and consistently.



Understanding the Importance of Loving Your Christian Neighbour

1. Love is the Proof of Discipleship

Jesus did not say the world would know us by our noise, knowledge, or activity. He said they would know us by our love. Pastor Chris Oyakhilome teaches that "love is the way of the Kingdom." If we cannot love fellow believers, then something is wrong in our spiritual life. Revival without love becomes religion without Christ's nature.

2. Love Protects the Unity of the Body of Christ

The enemy is always looking for ways to divide believers through offence, envy, strife, and misunderstanding. Charles Finney understood that revival could be weakened when relationships in the Church were broken. Love heals what division tries to destroy. It allows believers to walk together in peace, humility, and strength. Where there is genuine love, the atmosphere becomes favourable for God to move.

3. Love Requires Maturity and Selflessness

Loving others is not always easy. Sometimes it requires patience, forgiveness, and sacrifice. Kathryn Kuhlman often emphasised the tenderness of the Holy Spirit and how believers must avoid attitudes that grieve Him. Love is not merely emotion. It is choosing to respond with grace even when the flesh wants to react differently. A revived believer learns to put away bitterness and selfishness.

4. Your Love for Believers Reflects Your Love for Christ

You cannot claim to love God while refusing to love those who belong to Him. Prophet Emmanuel Makandiwa teaches that "the love of God must become practical in the way you handle people." Loving your Christian neighbour means praying for them, speaking well of them, supporting them, and refusing to become an instrument of division. This love reflects the character of Christ.

5. Love Strengthens Revival and Witness

When believers genuinely love one another, their witness becomes stronger. Reinhard Bonnke preached to vast crowds, but the gospel itself is most credible when the Church reflects the love it proclaims. A loving Church becomes attractive. A divided Church becomes weak. If you want revival to remain alive in your life, then you must let love remain active in your heart.

I walk in love toward my Christian neighbour, and my life reflects the nature of Christ.

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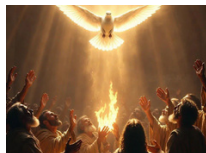
BUILDING A RELATIONSHIP WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT

2 CORINTHIANS 13:14

"May the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all."



The Holy Spirit is not merely a power to experience or a force to be used. He is a divine person with whom the believer is meant to have fellowship. Many Christians know about the Holy Spirit, but they do not know Him personally. They may desire His power, but they have not developed relationship with Him. Revival becomes deeper and more sustainable when the believer moves beyond occasional spiritual experiences into daily fellowship with the Holy Spirit.



Understanding How to Build a Relationship with the Holy Spirit

1. The Holy Spirit Desires Fellowship, Not Mere Acknowledgment

The Bible speaks of the fellowship of the Holy Spirit, which means communion, sharing, and relationship. Pastor Chris has taught extensively that the Holy Spirit is the greatest friend and helper of the believer. He is not distant. He wants to be known, listened to, and honoured. A believer who builds relationship with Him will grow in sensitivity, strength, and spiritual awareness.

2. Relationship is Built Through Time and Attention

No meaningful relationship develops without time. The same is true with the Holy Spirit. Dr Yonggi Cho taught that intimacy with the Holy Spirit grows through prayer, meditation, and conscious interaction. If a believer gives more attention to worldly distractions than to God's Spirit, intimacy will remain weak. But if you intentionally spend time with Him, your awareness of Him grows.

3. Honour Invites Greater Manifestation

The Holy Spirit is grieved when dishonoured, ignored, or resisted. Kathryn Kuhlman often spoke about the preciousness of the Holy Spirit and how carefully believers should treat His presence. When you honour Him with obedience, reverence, and purity, you create an atmosphere where His work becomes more evident in your life.

4. The Holy Spirit Guides, Teaches, and Strengthens

A relationship with the Holy Spirit is not abstract. It produces practical results. He teaches truth, gives direction, strengthens the inner man, and brings conviction when needed. Prophet Uebert Angel teaches that "when the Holy Spirit becomes real to you, life stops being ordinary." The believer who knows Him begins to walk with greater confidence and clarity.

5. Relationship with the Holy Spirit Sustains Revival

Revival cannot be maintained by emotion alone. It is sustained by ongoing communion with the Holy Spirit. Smith Wigglesworth's life reflected unusual dependence on the Spirit, and this produced remarkable spiritual results. If you want revival to remain alive in your life, your relationship with the Holy Spirit must remain active and growing.

CLOSING PRAYER

Daily Confession

I enjoy fellowship with the Holy Spirit, and my relationship with Him grows stronger every day.

Prayer

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13 August

HOW TO DETOX YOURSELF FROM WORLDLY PLEASURES

1 JOHN 2:15

"Do not love the world or anything in the world..."

One of the greatest enemies of revival is an uncontrolled attraction to worldly pleasures. The world offers temporary excitement, temporary satisfaction, and temporary escape, but it cannot satisfy the soul. When a believer becomes too attached to worldly pleasures, spiritual hunger begins to fade. Revival weakens when the heart is divided. To detox from worldly pleasures means to intentionally separate yourself from the things that dull your appetite for God and pull your affection away from Him.



Understanding How to Detox from Worldly Pleasures

1. Worldly Pleasures Dull Spiritual Appetite

The heart cannot burn strongly for God while constantly feeding on things that pull it in the opposite direction. Charles Finney warned that compromise with the world weakens the power of the believer. Pastor Chris teaches that your spirit responds to what you continually expose it to. If worldly pleasures are constantly feeding your flesh, spiritual hunger will naturally decline.

2. Temporary Enjoyment Can Produce Long-Term Weakness

Many worldly pleasures do not appear dangerous at first, but they slowly weaken discipline, reduce prayer, and make the things of God feel less urgent. Smith Wigglesworth guarded his inner life carefully, knowing that what entered the soul affected the spirit. The issue is not only sin in its obvious form. It is anything that competes with God for your affection and focus.

3. Detox Requires Deliberate Separation

You cannot detox by accident. You must intentionally cut off or reduce what feeds ungodly appetite. Prophet Emmanuel Makandiwa teaches that "deliverance is easier when the source is removed." This means some music, entertainment, relationships, habits, and environments may need to be reduced or completely removed if they are poisoning your spiritual life.

4. Replace Worldly Pleasures with Spiritual Nourishment

It is not enough to remove the wrong. You must also feed on the right. Dr Yonggi Cho emphasised the importance of building strong spiritual habits through prayer, Scripture, and worship. If the believer removes worldly influence but does not replace it with spiritual nourishment, they will remain empty and vulnerable. The heart must be refilled with the things of God.

5. Revival Requires Single-Hearted Pursuit

A revived life is not a divided life. Kathryn Kuhlman's ministry reflected a heart deeply surrendered to God. She knew that the Holy Spirit does not rest where the heart is full of competing desires. If you want fresh fire, then your affections must be aligned. The more you detox from worldly pleasures, the more room there is for God's presence to grow in you.

CLOSING PRAYER

Daily Confession

My heart belongs to God, and every worldly pleasure that weakens my spirit loses its hold over me.

Closing Prayer

Heavenly Father, cleanse my heart from every worldly attachment that weakens my hunger for You. Help me to let go of anything that competes with Your presence. Fill me afresh with desire for the things of God. In Jesus' name, I pray. Amen.

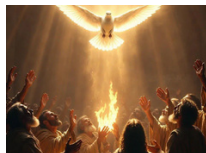
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THE ROLE OF PROPER FASTING IN REVIVAL

MATTHEW 6:17–18

"But when you fast... your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you."

Fasting has always been a significant part of spiritual awakening and revival. It is not a religious performance meant to impress people, nor is it a way of forcing God to move. Proper fasting is a spiritual discipline that humbles the flesh, sharpens the spirit, and creates greater sensitivity to God. Many revivalists understood the power of fasting because they knew that there are dimensions of spiritual intensity that require deeper consecration. Revival often intensifies when believers deny the flesh and seek God with seriousness.



Understanding the Role of Proper Fasting in Revival

1. Fasting Weakens the Flesh and Strengthens Spiritual Focus

The flesh often competes with the spirit. Fasting helps put the flesh in its proper place. John Knox and many other men of revival practised deep consecration because they understood that spiritual power increases when the flesh is subdued. Pastor Chris teaches that fasting is one of the ways to condition your spirit to be more responsive to God.

2. Fasting Creates Greater Sensitivity to the Holy Spirit

When normal physical comforts are reduced, the believer often becomes more spiritually alert. Dr Yonggi Cho emphasised prayer and fasting as essential tools for deepening spiritual capacity. Proper fasting does not automatically produce revival, but it positions the believer to hear more clearly, pray more deeply, and respond more quickly to God.

3. Fasting Must Be Joined with Prayer and the Word

Fasting without prayer becomes a physical exercise. Fasting without the Word becomes empty discipline. Charles Finney taught that spiritual disciplines must remain connected to divine purpose. Proper fasting is effective when the believer uses that period to pray, meditate on Scripture, repent, and align with God's will.

4. Fasting Helps Break Spiritual Stagnation

There are seasons when a believer may feel dull, dry, or spiritually slow. Fasting can help reset spiritual focus. Kathryn Kuhlman knew the importance of maintaining a consecrated inner life if the presence of God was to remain strong. Fasting helps strip away distractions and bring the heart back into seriousness before God.

5. Revival Fasting Must Be Done with Humility and Right Motive

The goal of fasting is not spiritual pride. It is greater surrender. Prophet Uebert Angel teaches that spiritual practices without humility can become empty. Proper fasting must come from a sincere desire for God, not from a desire to appear spiritual. When done correctly, it becomes a powerful part of revival preparation.

As I fast with the right heart, my spirit is sharpened and positioned for revival.

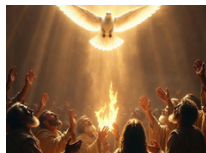
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HOW TO PRAY FOR SPIRITUAL REVIVAL

PSALM 85:6

"Will you not revive us again, that your people may rejoice in you?"

Revival prayer is different from ordinary routine prayer. It comes from a heart that is desperate to see God move, to see hearts changed, and to see His presence become more evident. Revival is not sustained by talent, planning, or noise. It is birthed and maintained through prayer. Throughout history, every true move of God has been preceded by believers who prayed with urgency, burden, humility, and expectation. If you want revival, you must learn how to pray for it.



Understanding How to Pray for Spiritual Revival

1. Revival Prayer Begins with Personal Brokenness

Before praying for national or corporate revival, the believer must allow revival to begin within. Charles Finney taught that many pray for revival while ignoring the areas in their own life that need repentance. Revival prayer begins with a heart that says, "Lord, start with me." Brokenness removes pride and makes room for God.

2. Revival Prayer Must Carry Hunger and Burden

Cold prayers rarely produce burning revival. John Knox's prayers were effective because they carried weight. He was not casually religious. He was desperate. Pastor Chris teaches that earnestness in prayer reflects value. If revival matters to you, your prayer life will show it. Burden gives force to prayer.

3. Prayer for Conviction, Repentance, and Awakening

Revival is not only about meetings. It is about hearts turning back to God. When praying for revival, ask God to awaken sleeping believers, convict sinners, expose compromise, and restore first love. Billy Graham's ministry was marked by strong calls to repentance because conviction is part of revival. Pray for hearts to become sensitive again.

4. Prayer with Faith and Expectation

Revival prayer must be mixed with faith. Reinhard Bonnke believed that when the gospel was preached and prayer was made, God would move. Prophet Emmanuel Makandwa teaches that expectation is part of receiving. Pray believing that God is willing to move and that your prayer matters.

5. Pray Consistently Until There is Evidence of Change

Revival is not always birthed instantly. It often requires persistent prayer. Dr Yonggi Cho emphasised that spiritual breakthrough often comes to those who refuse to stop praying. Keep praying until dryness gives way to hunger, until coldness gives way to fire, and until change begins to appear. Persistence is part of revival prayer.

Daily Confession

My prayers carry revival fire, and God moves in response to sincere and faith-filled intercession.

Closing Prayer

Heavenly Father, revive me again and revive Your people. Let conviction, repentance, and hunger spread through our hearts. Teach me to pray with burden, faith, and consistency until revival becomes evident. In Jesus' name, I pray. Amen.

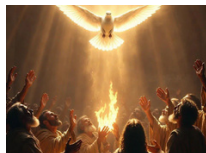
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IT IS BY GOD'S GRACE

ZECHARIAH 4:6

"Not by might nor by power, but by my Spirit," says the Lord Almighty.

One of the greatest dangers in revival is forgetting that everything begins, continues, and succeeds by the grace of God. Revival is not produced by human brilliance, effort, or strength alone. It is by God's mercy and by His Spirit. A believer may pray, fast, preach, and labour, but without grace, no lasting fruit can be produced. Grace keeps the believer humble, dependent, and spiritually balanced. It reminds us that all true progress in God comes from Him.



Understanding That Revival is by God's Grace

1. Grace Removes Human Pride from Spiritual Work

When a believer understands grace, they stop boasting in themselves. Kathryn Kuhlman often said that she was merely a yielded vessel and that the power belonged to God. Revival becomes dangerous when men begin to think they produced it. Grace reminds us that God is the source of all true spiritual fruit.

2. Grace Empowers What Human Strength Cannot Sustain

There are dimensions of prayer, holiness, consistency, and impact that cannot be sustained by willpower alone. Pastor Chris teaches that grace is divine enablement. Grace strengthens the believer to do what the natural man could not do consistently. Revival fire is maintained by divine help.

3. Grace Keeps the Believer Dependent on the Holy Spirit

Human skill can create activity, but only grace can sustain true spiritual life. Smith Wigglesworth understood deep dependence on God, and this dependence kept him from leaning on flesh. Grace teaches the believer to rely on the Holy Spirit rather than on personal confidence or experience.

4. Grace Produces Humility and Gratitude

A revived believer should become more humble, not more proud. Reinhard Bonnke's ministry reached millions, yet he remained conscious that it was the grace of God at work. Grace keeps the heart thankful. It reminds us that every open door, every soul saved, every revival touch, and every spiritual increase is an expression of God's kindness.

5. Grace Makes Great Impact Possible

What God has called you to do will require grace. Prophet Uebert Angel teaches that grace gives a man unusual capacity. When grace is active, the believer can carry more, endure more, and accomplish more for the kingdom. This is why revival must never be approached with self-sufficiency. It must be approached with dependence on grace.

By the grace of God, I am strengthened, sustained, and fruitful in every area of revival.

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THE JOY OF THE LORD VS HAPPINESS

NEHEMIAH 8:10

"Do not grieve, for the joy of the Lord is your strength."



Many people confuse joy with happiness, but they are not the same. Happiness is often tied to circumstances. It rises and falls depending on what is happening around you. Joy, however, is deeper. The joy of the Lord is spiritual strength that comes from God's presence and from confidence in Him. In revival, joy becomes very important because it sustains the believer beyond changing emotions and situations. A believer may face pressure outwardly and still carry inward joy because that joy comes from God, not from conditions.



Understanding the Joy of the Lord vs Happiness

1. Happiness Depends on Circumstances, Joy Comes from God

Happiness often changes quickly. If things go well, people feel happy. If things go wrong, happiness fades. But the joy of the Lord is different. It flows from relationship with God and confidence in His faithfulness. Pastor Chris teaches that joy is a product of the recreated human spirit, not merely a reaction to outward events.

2. Joy Strengthens the Believer During Difficult Seasons

Nehemiah says that the joy of the Lord is strength. This means joy is not ornamental; it is functional. It helps the believer endure, remain hopeful, and continue moving forward. Charles Finney saw that true spiritual awakening often restored holy joy to the people. Joy energises the inner man in ways that natural encouragement cannot.

3. Revival Often Restores Deep Spiritual Joy

When God revives His people, heaviness begins to lift and joy returns. Kathryn Kuhlman's meetings often carried a sense of holy joy because the presence of God was tangible. This joy was not shallow excitement. It was the result of people encountering God. Revival restores joy because it restores communion.

4. Joy Must Be Protected from the Thief of Discouragement

The enemy attacks joy because he knows it strengthens the believer. Discouragement, offence, fear, and constant negativity can drain joy if they are not resisted. Prophet Emmanuel Makandiwa teaches that believers must guard their spirit from things that weaken their strength. Joy must be cultivated through thanksgiving, prayer, and focus on God.

5. A Joyful Believer Carries Greater Spiritual Influence

Joy makes the Christian life attractive. Reinhard Bonnke preached with passion and visible joy because the gospel itself is good news. A believer filled with joy becomes a stronger witness than one who always appears defeated. Joy reflects confidence in God, and that confidence has influence.

Daily Confession

The joy of the Lord is my strength, and my spirit remains strong regardless of circumstances.

Closing Prayer

Heavenly Father, fill me with Your joy. Help me not to depend on circumstances for strength, but on Your presence. Let Your joy strengthen my heart and sustain my revival. In Jesus' name, I pray. Amen.

THE ROLE OF POSITIVE DECLARATIONS IN REVIVAL

MARK 11:23

"Truly I tell you, if anyone says to this mountain, 'Go, throw yourself into the sea,' and does not doubt in their heart but believes that what they say will happen, it will be done for them."

What a believer says matters greatly, especially during seasons of spiritual revival. Revival is not sustained by negative speech, defeatist language, or careless confession. Positive declarations, when rooted in Scripture and spoken in faith, help align the believer with God's truth. They do not replace prayer, obedience, or the Word, but they reinforce them. Revival grows stronger when the mouth agrees with what God says.



Understanding the Role of Positive Declarations in Revival

1. Declarations Align the Heart with God's Word

When you speak what God says, you strengthen that truth in your own heart. Pastor Chris teaches that confession builds consciousness. If a believer constantly speaks weakness, dryness, and defeat, that language shapes expectation. But when they declare life, fire, hunger, and victory according to Scripture, their heart begins to align with God's reality.

2. The Mouth Can Sustain or Sabotage Revival

A careless mouth can quench spiritual momentum. Negative words, murmuring, and hopeless speech weaken the believer's spirit. Smith Wigglesworth was known for refusing negative confessions because he understood the power of words. Revival is strengthened when believers speak in agreement with God instead of reinforcing darkness.

3. Declarations Must Be Rooted in Truth, Not Mere Positivity

Biblical declaration is not empty optimism. It is faith-filled agreement with the Word of God. Prophet Uebert Angel often teaches the power of speaking in alignment with divine truth. The believer must not speak positively just to feel better; they must speak scripturally to establish truth in the atmosphere of their life.

4. Consistent Declarations Build Spiritual Atmosphere

Atmospheres are shaped by what is repeatedly spoken. Dr Yonggi Cho taught that words of faith and hope help create an environment where spiritual growth becomes easier. If a household, church, or believer consistently speaks revival, hunger, boldness, and life, that atmosphere begins to reflect those realities more strongly.

5. Declarations Help the Believer Stand Against Opposition

Revival often faces resistance. In such moments, positive declarations help the believer remain spiritually positioned. Reinhard Bonnke spoke with bold certainty because he believed the Word of God had final authority. Declarations of life, hunger, fire, and victory help preserve faith when opposition rises.

CLOSING PRAYER

Daily Confession

I declare life, revival, hunger, and victory, and my words align with the truth of God.

Closing Prayer

Heavenly Father, help me to speak in agreement with Your Word. Let my declarations strengthen my spirit and create an atmosphere of revival around me. Teach me to use my mouth for life, faith, and truth. In Jesus' name, I pray. Amen.

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HOW TO MAINTAIN YOUR CHRISTIAN REVIVAL

1 THESSALONIANS 5:19

"Do not quench the Spirit."

It is one thing to experience revival, and it is another thing to maintain it. Many believers have moments of fire, seasons of hunger, or times of spiritual intensity, but they later drift into coldness because they do not know how to sustain what God has started. Revival must be protected. It must be fed. It must be maintained through discipline, sensitivity, and consistent pursuit of God. If revival is not maintained, it fades into memory rather than continuing as lifestyle.



Understanding How to Maintain Christian Revival

1. Revival Must Be Fed Through Daily Fellowship with God

Fire does not remain without fuel. The believer must continue in prayer, the Word, worship, and fellowship with the Holy Spirit. Pastor Chris teaches that spiritual growth and fire are sustained by constant exposure to divine truth. If daily fellowship weakens, revival will begin to cool.

2. Revival Must Be Protected from Distraction

One of the quickest ways revival fades is through distraction. Worldliness, busyness, compromise, and spiritual carelessness slowly weaken hunger. The Holy Spirit is not maintained by emotion alone. He must be obeyed. Kathryn Kuhlman's life teaches the importance of protecting sensitivity to the Spirit. If God convicts, instructs, or corrects you and you respond quickly, revival remains stronger. Delayed obedience weakens spiritual momentum.

4. Consistent Discipline Keeps Revival Alive

Revival is sustained through spiritual order. Smith Wigglesworth did not rely on feelings. He cultivated consistency. Prayer times, fasting, Scripture reading, holy living, and godly speech all help maintain the fire that God has lit. Revival becomes stable when discipline supports it.

5. Revival Must Overflow Into Service and Soul Winning

Revival that remains self-centred eventually weakens. Fire is maintained when it is shared. Reinhard Bonnke's revival passion expressed itself in evangelism and reaching souls. When your fire blesses others, encourages believers, and reaches the lost, it remains active. Revival must not only be felt — it must be expressed.

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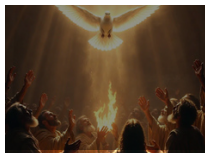
AIM TO WIN THE GLOBE FOR JESUS CHRIST

MARK 16:15

"Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation."



The gospel was never meant to remain local, limited, or private. Jesus gave a global commission. This means the believer must carry a global vision in their heart, even if their immediate assignment begins with one person, one street, one church, or one community. Revival must never become self-contained. If your heart has been touched by God, then your vision must begin to expand beyond yourself. To aim to win the globe for Jesus Christ means to align your heart with the scale of God's desire.



Understanding the Global Aim of Revival

1. The Great Commission is Global in Scope

Jesus did not say preach only where it is easy or familiar. He said go into all the world. Reinhard Bonnke's ministry carried this global burden strongly, especially for Africa, because he believed nations belonged to Christ. Every believer must let their thinking expand beyond their immediate world. Revival is too powerful to remain private.

2. A Global Vision Begins with a Kingdom Heart

You may not travel the world physically, but your heart can still carry the nations. Billy Graham, Bonnke, and many revivalists laboured with a broad kingdom vision. Pastor Chris teaches that when your thinking is shaped by the kingdom, your life stops revolving around small ambitions. God wants believers who care about cities, nations, and generations.

3. Winning the Globe Begins with Winning the One in Front of You

Global impact does not begin with size. It begins with obedience. If you cannot witness to one, you are not yet walking in the spirit of the Great Commission. John G. Lake understood that spiritual influence grows from faithful action in present opportunities. The person in front of you matters. Revival vision grows through faithful obedience in small beginnings.

4. The Holy Spirit Empowers Global Evangelistic Purpose

Acts 1:8 connects the Holy Spirit with witness to the ends of the earth. Dr Yonggi Cho understood that the power of the Spirit is not only for personal blessing but for global gospel advancement. The believer must remain conscious that the Holy Spirit empowers mission, not just experience. Revival should push you outward.

5. Aim High Because Christ Deserves the Nations

The nations belong to Jesus. Prophet Uebert Angel often teaches believers to think bigger because the kingdom of God is vast. Small thinking limits impact. When your vision grows, your prayers grow, your faith grows, and your obedience grows. Revival teaches the believer to stop living only for personal survival and start living for kingdom conquest.

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THE POWER OF THE TRUTH

JOHN 8:32

"Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."

Truth is one of the greatest forces in the life of a believer. It is more than accurate information. Truth carries liberating power. It exposes darkness, corrects deception, aligns the heart with God, and brings freedom where bondage once existed. Many believers struggle not because freedom is unavailable, but because truth has not yet fully taken root in their hearts. Revival always has a strong relationship with truth, because where revival is real, truth becomes sharper, clearer, and harder to ignore. God revives His people by bringing them back to His truth.



Understanding the Power of the Truth

1. Truth Reveals What Darkness Tries to Hide

Darkness survives in concealment, confusion, and deception. But truth exposes what has been hidden. Charles Finney's revivals were marked by conviction because truth was being preached with such force that hidden sin could no longer remain comfortable. Pastor Chris Oyakhilome teaches that "when truth enters your spirit, error loses its power." Revival increases where truth is boldly embraced.

2. Truth Produces Genuine Freedom

Jesus did not say truth would merely inform you. He said it would set you free. Freedom from fear, bondage, sin, confusion, and spiritual stagnation comes when truth is known and received. Kathryn Kuhlman often emphasised that the Holy Spirit works deeply where people surrender to what God says. Freedom is not built on feelings. It is built on truth.

3. Truth Corrects False Identity and Wrong Thinking

Many believers remain trapped because they believe lies about themselves, about God, or about their situation. The truth of God's Word corrects these internal strongholds. Smith Wigglesworth refused to build his life on feelings or natural appearances. He stood on truth. When the believer accepts truth, their thinking begins to align with heaven, and their life begins to change.

4. Truth Strengthens Revival and Spiritual Stability

Revival that is not grounded in truth can become emotional but unstable. True revival always drives people deeper into Scripture and greater alignment with God's Word. Prophet Emmanuel Makandiwa teaches that spiritual strength grows when revelation is received and applied. The believer who is rooted in truth will not be easily moved by deception or pressure.

5. Truth Must Be Loved, Not Just Heard

It is possible to hear truth and still resist it. The believer must not only receive truth intellectually but love it deeply. Reinhard Bonnke preached the gospel with urgency because truth is not optional — it is the means by which men are saved. If revival is to remain strong, believers must become lovers of truth, not just listeners.

DO NOT BE IGNORANT OF SATAN AND HIS DEVICES

2 CORINTHIANS 2:11

"...in order that Satan might not outwit us. For we are not unaware of his schemes."

One of the enemy's greatest advantages against believers is ignorance. Satan often works through subtlety, deception, distraction, and carefully repeated strategies. He studies weaknesses, patterns, and opportunities. This is why Scripture warns believers not to be ignorant of his devices. The goal is not to become obsessed with the devil, but to become aware enough to resist him wisely. Revival-minded believers must be spiritually alert. A careless believer becomes easy prey, but an informed believer is harder to trap.



Understanding Satan's Devices

1. The Enemy Often Works Through Subtlety Rather Than Obvious Attack

Satan does not always come in openly dramatic ways. Often, he works gradually through compromise, confusion, distraction, offence, and deception. Watchman Nee understood that spiritual warfare often involves subtle inner battles more than obvious outward events. Pastor Chris teaches that discernment is necessary because not every spiritual battle appears dramatic at first.

2. Ignorance Gives the Enemy Room to Operate

If a believer does not understand how the enemy works, they may unknowingly cooperate with him through fear, careless speech, bitterness, or disobedience. John G. Lake understood that light weakens darkness. Once the believer becomes aware of the enemy's devices, many of his strategies lose their surprise and effectiveness.

3. The Enemy Uses Repetition to Create Strongholds

Many satanic strategies work through repeated patterns — repeated temptation, repeated discouragement, repeated lies, repeated compromise. Charles Finney knew that habitual sin and spiritual decline often strengthened each other until truth interrupted the cycle. A believer must recognise repeated patterns and confront them spiritually before they become strongholds.

4. Discernment and the Word Expose Satan's Devices

The Word of God is one of the believer's greatest protections. Smith Wigglesworth used Scripture as a weapon because he knew that the devil cannot overpower truth. Prophet Uebert Angel often teaches that revelation gives the believer an advantage. Discernment and scriptural knowledge expose what the enemy is trying to do.

5. Awareness Must Lead to Resistance, Not Fear

The purpose of knowing Satan's devices is not fear but victory. The believer must remain Christ-conscious while also being spiritually alert. Reinhard Bonnke kept his focus on Christ but was not careless about spiritual opposition. When a believer is aware and submitted to God, the enemy's devices become easier to defeat.

I am not ignorant of Satan's devices, and I walk in discernment, wisdom, and victory through Christ.

Closing Prayer

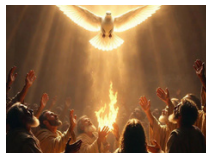
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BEWARE OF MAMMON

MATTHEW 6:24

"You cannot serve both God and money."

Mammon is more than money itself. It represents a spirit of misplaced trust, greed, and devotion to material security above God. This is why Jesus spoke strongly about it. The issue is not merely having money. It is serving it, trusting it, or making it the center of life. Mammon competes with God for the heart. Revival weakens where mammon is enthroned, because a heart divided between God and worldly security cannot burn fully for Him.



Understanding the Danger of Mammon

1. Mammon Demands Trust That Belongs to God

Money is a tool, but mammon turns it into a master. Pastor Chris teaches that God must remain the believer's source, not financial systems. When a person begins to trust wealth more than God, their spiritual life becomes vulnerable. Mammon says, "Depend on me," but faith says, "Depend on God."

2. Mammon Pulls the Heart Away from Revival

Revival requires hunger, surrender, and spiritual focus. Mammon pulls the heart toward self-preservation, greed, and worldly ambition. Oral Roberts understood that finances must be placed under God's authority if kingdom work is to flourish. A heart controlled by mammon will struggle to flow freely in revival because it is too attached to earthly security.

3. Mammon Can Hide Behind Respectability

Unlike some sins that appear openly destructive, mammon can seem respectable. A believer may appear disciplined and successful while inwardly becoming more dependent on wealth than on God. Charles Finney often confronted respectable sins because he knew they could quietly harden the heart. Mammon is dangerous because it often hides behind "wisdom" while undermining faith.

4. Generosity and Contentment Break Mammon's Hold

One of the ways to fight mammon is through generosity. Giving reminds the heart that God is the source and that money is not God. Prophet Uebert Angel often teaches that giving breaks the control of greed and strengthens trust in divine supply. Contentment also protects the heart from endless striving.

5. Revival Requires Wholehearted Devotion to God Alone

Mammon and revival do not coexist comfortably. A revived believer must choose where trust will rest. Reinhard Bonnke lived with kingdom urgency because the gospel mattered more to him than personal gain. If the believer is to walk in sustained revival, then God must be enthroned above all material things.

CLOSING PRAYER

God alone is my source, my trust, and my master. Mammon has no hold over my heart.

Closing Prayer

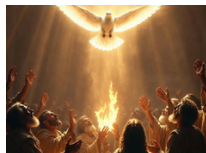
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LEARN THE ART OF WORSHIP IN REVIVAL

JOHN 4:24

"God is spirit, and his worshipers must worship in the Spirit and in truth."

Worship is one of the deepest expressions of relationship with God. According to Jean Major Sr, worship is based on a divine encounter, while praise is based on what God has done. This distinction is important. Praise celebrates the acts of God. Worship responds to who God is and often flows from a deep encounter with His presence. In revival, worship becomes especially powerful because it creates space for the believer to adore, surrender, and respond to God beyond routine language. The art of worship is not performance — it is a spiritual response born from revelation.



Understanding the Art of Worship in Revival

1. Worship Flows from Encounter, Not Routine

A person can sing songs without truly worshipping. But when someone has encountered God, worship begins to rise from a deeper place. Jean Major Sr's distinction is important because it helps believers understand that worship is not merely music. It is response to revelation. Kathryn Kuhlman's meetings often carried strong atmospheres of worship because people were responding to the presence of God, not just to a program.

2. Worship Requires Spirit and Truth

Jesus said true worshipers must worship in spirit and in truth. This means worship must be sincere and aligned with God's reality. Pastor Chris teaches that worship is not only emotional expression; it is conscious response from the spirit. In revival, worship is strengthened when the believer is truthful before God, free from pretense, and deeply aware of His holiness.

3. Worship Leads to Surrender and Transformation

True worship changes the worshiper. When a believer genuinely worships, pride weakens, self is reduced, and the heart becomes more yielded. William Seymour and the Azusa Revival showed that where people truly encountered God, worship was not shallow. It led to repentance, humility, and openness to the Holy Spirit.

4. Praise and Worship Work Together but Are Not the Same

Praise celebrates God's works — His goodness, faithfulness, victory, and mighty acts. Worship goes deeper into adoration of His person. Both are important, but the distinction matters because revival needs both celebration and encounter. Prophet Emmanuel Makandiwa often teaches that believers must not remain shallow in spiritual expression. Revival grows stronger when praise leads into worship and worship leads into encounter.

5. Worship Sustains the Atmosphere of Revival

Where true worship exists, the atmosphere remains open to God's presence. Dr Yonggi Cho taught that worship helps maintain spiritual sensitivity and expectation. A believer who learns to worship deeply will find it easier to stay connected to God's presence even outside corporate gatherings. Revival is strengthened when worship becomes lifestyle, not event.

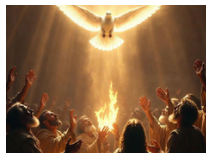
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UNDERSTANDING PERILOUS TIMES

2 TIMOTHY 3:1

"But mark this: There will be terrible times in the last days."

Perilous times are not merely difficult seasons. They are spiritually dangerous times marked by deception, moral decline, selfishness, rebellion, confusion, and pressure against truth. The Bible warns believers that such times will come, not to frighten them, but to prepare them. A revived believer must understand the times they are living in. Without this understanding, it is easy to drift with the culture instead of standing in truth. Revival-minded believers must be sober, watchful, and grounded in God's Word.



Understanding Perilous Times

1. Perilous Times Are Spiritually Dangerous, Not Just Socially Difficult

The danger of perilous times is not only hardship but spiritual corrosion. Values become distorted, truth becomes resisted, and darkness begins to look normal. Charles Finney understood the danger of spiritual decline in culture and constantly called people back to repentance. Believers must not underestimate the seriousness of the times.

2. Perilous Times Demand Greater Discernment

When times are dangerous, discernment becomes essential. Pastor Chris teaches that believers must not live by the news or by culture, but by the Spirit and the Word. In confusing times, discernment helps the believer separate truth from deception and remain anchored in Christ.

3. Believers Must Not Be Carried by the Spirit of the Age

Every generation has a dominant spirit that tries to shape values and beliefs. In perilous times, the pressure to compromise increases. Watchman Nee wrote deeply about the difference between spiritual life and worldly conformity. A revived believer must resist being moulded by the times and instead remain shaped by God.

4. Perilous Times Are Also Opportunities for Revival Witness

Darkness often creates greater contrast for the light. Reinhard Bonnke ministered with urgency because he believed the gospel shines brightest in the midst of darkness. Dangerous times are not only reasons to hide — they are reasons to burn brighter. Revival can become more powerful in dark seasons.

5. The Word of God Must Become Even More Central

Perilous times make Scripture even more necessary. If the believer is not grounded in truth, the pressure of the times can overwhelm them. Smith Wigglesworth's unwavering dependence on Scripture reminds us that the Word is not optional in dark days. It is survival, strength, and guidance.

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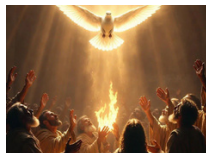
DO NOT COMPROMISE YOUR CHRISTIANITY

ROMANS 12:2

"Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind."

"Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind."

Compromise is one of the most dangerous threats to spiritual revival. It rarely begins dramatically. It often starts with small adjustments, little excuses, and subtle agreements with what God has not approved. Over time, compromise weakens conviction, dulls hunger, and reduces spiritual power. A believer who wants to remain revived must guard their faith carefully. Christianity cannot be effective when it is mixed with disobedience, worldliness, or fear of man.



Understanding the Danger of Compromising Christianity

1. Compromise Begins Small but Grows Over Time

Many believers do not fall suddenly. They drift gradually. Charles Finney warned that spiritual decline often begins with little neglected convictions. The enemy knows that small compromises can eventually lead to major weakness. This is why the believer must be sensitive to early signs of drift.

2. Compromise Weakens Spiritual Authority

A believer living in compromise will struggle to stand boldly in prayer, witness, and spiritual warfare. Pastor Chris teaches that righteousness-consciousness strengthens the believer. When compromise is tolerated, confidence weakens and spiritual boldness declines.

3. The Pressure to Fit In Must Be Resisted

Perilous times increase the pressure to conform. Smith Wigglesworth refused to be shaped by culture, opinion, or social pressure. The revived believer must be willing to stand out rather than blend in. It is better to be holy and misunderstood than accepted and compromised.

4. The Holy Spirit is Grieved by Persistent Compromise

The Spirit of God is holy. Kathryn Kuhlman often emphasised how easily the Holy Spirit can be grieved by impurity, pride, or disobedience. Revival cannot remain strong where compromise is protected. A believer must remain tender and quick to repent.

5. Conviction Must Be Protected Through the Word and Prayer

Conviction is maintained by consistent exposure to truth. If a believer neglects prayer and Scripture, compromise becomes easier. Prophet Emmanuel Makandiwa teaches that a strong spirit is harder to corrupt. The more alive your spirit is, the less attractive compromise becomes.

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UNDERSTANDING THE ROLE OF PROPHECY IN REVIVAL

1 TIMOTHY 1:18

"...so that by recalling them you may fight the battle well."

Prophecy has an important role in revival because it strengthens faith, reveals God's heart, brings direction, and awakens expectation. Throughout Scripture and revival history, prophetic words have often prepared people for what God was about to do or confirmed what He was already doing. However, prophecy must always remain under the authority of Scripture and the leading of the Holy Spirit. When properly understood, prophecy becomes a tool of edification and spiritual advancement.



Understanding the Role of Prophecy in Revival

1. Prophecy Strengthens and Encourages Believers

Biblical prophecy is meant to edify, exhort, and comfort. In revival, prophecy often awakens believers to divine purpose and reminds them of God's intention. Pastor Chris teaches that prophecy can bring alignment and spiritual direction when received rightly. A discouraged believer can be strengthened by a word from God.

2. Prophecy Can Prepare the Church for Divine Movement

Revival is often sustained when believers remember what God has said and continue standing on it.

5. True Prophecy Points to Christ and Produces Holiness

If prophecy becomes self-centered, manipulative, or detached from Christ, it has lost its proper place. Charles Finney valued manifestations that led people closer to truth and holiness. True prophecy in revival should produce humility, faith, repentance, and greater love for God. It should help build the Church, not confuse it.

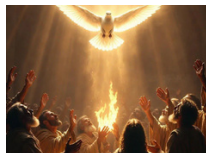
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BEWARE OF DOGS IN CHURCH

PHILIPPIANS 3:2

"Watch out for those dogs, those evildoers, those mutilators of the flesh."

The Bible sometimes uses strong language to warn believers about dangerous people within the visible community of faith. In this context, "dogs" refers not to ordinary weakness or immaturity, but to destructive individuals who carry wrong motives, corrupt influence, or harmful doctrine. A revived Church must not be naive. Love and discernment must work together. It is possible to welcome people warmly while still recognising that not everyone who is present is safe to follow or trust.



Understanding Why Believers Must Beware

1. Not Everyone in Church Carries the Spirit of Christ

Being in church does not automatically mean a person is spiritually healthy or trustworthy. Charles Finney knew that revival often exposed false motives among those around the work of God. Some people remain around spiritual environments while carrying envy, manipulation, division, or self-interest. The believer must learn discernment.

2. Destructive People Often Hide Behind Religious Language

Dangerous influences in church do not always appear openly rebellious. Sometimes they use Scripture, titles, or outward spirituality to cover wrong intentions. Pastor Chris teaches that believers must judge fruit, not be impressed by appearance. If the fruit is disorder, deception, pride, or constant strife, caution is necessary.

3. Wrong Influence Can Weaken Revival

A revived environment is precious, and the enemy often sends disruptive influences to contaminate it. Kathryn Kuhlman guarded the atmosphere of her meetings carefully because she understood that not every spirit supports the move of God. Wrong people can bring confusion, suspicion, and distraction if not recognised.

4. Discernment Must Be Balanced with Love and Wisdom

This warning is not permission for harsh judgment or paranoia. It is a call to wisdom. Watchman Nee understood the importance of spiritual discernment within the Body of Christ. Believers must remain loving, but not foolish; open-hearted, but not undiscerning. Revival requires both compassion and vigilance.

5. True Safety is Found in Staying Close to God's Voice

Ultimately, the Holy Spirit protects believers from harmful influence when they remain prayerful and attentive. Prophet Emmanuel Makandiwa teaches that spiritual sensitivity helps you detect what natural observation may miss. The more you stay close to God, the easier it becomes to recognise unhealthy influence.

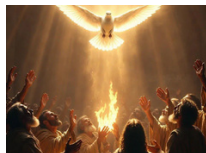
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SIGNS OF FAKE OR FALSE MEMBERS IN CHURCH

MATTHEW 7:16

"By their fruit you will recognize them."

Not everyone who appears committed to church life is genuinely surrendered to Christ. Some people participate outwardly while remaining inwardly disconnected from truth, holiness, and genuine transformation. Revival demands sincerity. This is why believers must be discerning. The goal is not to become suspicious of everyone, but to understand that fruit matters more than appearance. A revived Church must recognise falsehood so that truth can remain strong.



Understanding Signs of False Members

1. Appearance Without Fruit is a Warning Sign

A person may know the language of church yet lack the fruit of repentance, humility, love, and obedience. Jesus said we would know people by their fruit, not by their claims. Pastor Chris teaches that Christianity must be expressed in life, not merely in words. Revival increases authenticity and exposes pretence.

2. False Members Often Resist Conviction and Correction

One common sign of falsehood is resistance to repentance. Charles Finney's revivals exposed hearts because the convicting presence of God made it difficult to remain neutral. Genuine believers may stumble, but they remain correctable. False people often protect image while resisting transformation.

3. They May Stir Division, Gossip, or Secret Disorder

False members often bring unhealthy atmospheres. Instead of building the Body, they weaken trust and create disorder. Kathryn Kuhlman understood that the move of God could be hindered by hidden strife and wrong spirits. A revived believer should pay attention to whether someone's presence builds or damages spiritual unity.

4. They Love Position More Than Purity

Some false members desire recognition, influence, or closeness to leadership without genuine surrender to God. Reinhard Bonnke remained focused on souls and Christ, not platform politics. False people are often more interested in appearance, proximity, and status than in holiness and service.

5. The Holy Spirit Helps Expose What is False

Believers do not have to depend only on natural observation. The Holy Spirit gives discernment. Prophet Uebert Angel teaches that spiritual perception helps believers recognise what is hidden behind outward presentation. The more prayerful and Word-rooted you are, the easier it becomes to identify what is real and what is not.

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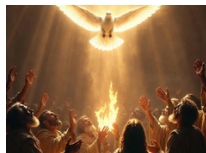

CONTROLLING THE SPIRITUAL ATMOSPHERE AROUND YOU

PROVERBS 18:21

"The tongue has the power of life and death..."

Atmospheres matter. The spiritual atmosphere around a believer can either strengthen or weaken their walk with God. While some environments are shaped by many external factors, the believer is not powerless within them. Through prayer, words, worship, holiness, and the presence of the Holy Spirit, a believer can influence the spiritual atmosphere around them. Revival often grows where atmospheres are intentionally guarded and shaped in alignment with God.



Understanding How to Control Spiritual Atmosphere

1. Your Words Help Shape Atmosphere

Words are not empty. They release life or death, faith or fear, hope or discouragement. Pastor Chris teaches that your mouth helps frame your environment. If a believer constantly speaks defeat, negativity, and unbelief, they help create a dry atmosphere. But if they speak life, faith, truth, and revival, the atmosphere begins to shift.

2. Prayer Changes Invisible Conditions

Prayer affects more than the person praying. It changes spiritual conditions. Dr Yonggi Cho taught that prayer creates the environment for God to move. Many revivalists understood that before visible breakthrough appears, invisible conditions must shift first. Prayer invites divine order into places where confusion once ruled.

3. Worship and Praise Shift Spiritual Climate

Worship draws attention to God and helps re-centre the atmosphere around His presence. As Jean Major Sr taught, praise is based on what God has done, while worship is based on divine encounter. Both have power in shaping spiritual environment. Kathryn Kuhlman's meetings often carried strong atmospheres because worship was genuine and presence-centred.

4. Purity and Obedience Protect Atmosphere

A believer cannot create a godly atmosphere while living carelessly. Personal holiness matters. Smith Wigglesworth guarded his spirit carefully because he understood that spiritual authority and atmosphere are connected. If your personal life is polluted, the atmosphere around you will struggle to remain spiritually strong.

5. The Holy Spirit Responds to Intentional Spiritual Stewardship

Believers must become aware that they are stewards of atmosphere in their homes, relationships, churches, and personal lives. Prophet Emmanuel Makandiwa teaches that spiritual sensitivity increases when believers intentionally guard what surrounds them. Revival grows more easily where the atmosphere is protected.

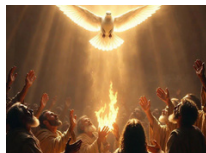
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CALL FOR SPIRITUAL REVIVAL IN YOUR HOME

Revival should not remain limited to church services or public gatherings. One of the greatest places revival must reach is the home. A revived home becomes a place of prayer, peace, truth, worship, and spiritual influence. Many believers desire revival in the church while neglecting the spiritual condition of their own household. But if revival is truly from God, it should affect family life, conversations, habits, priorities, and the atmosphere at home. The home can become a powerful centre of God's presence.



Understanding How to Call for Revival in Your Home

1. Revival in the Home Begins with Personal Fire

The first step to bringing revival into the home is allowing revival to burn in you personally. You cannot release what you do not carry. John Knox, Charles Finney, and many revivalists carried fire inwardly before their influence spread outwardly. If your personal life is cold, it will be difficult to build a revived atmosphere at home. Revival in the house often starts with one burning believer.

2. The Home Must Be Given to Prayer and the Word

A revived home is not built only on good intentions. It must be built on spiritual habits. Family prayer, Scripture reading, godly conversation, and intentional moments of worship help establish the house in truth. Pastor Chris teaches that the home must be a place where the Word has authority. Where God's Word is honoured, revival becomes more sustainable.

3. Spiritual Atmosphere in the Home Must Be Protected

What enters the home matters. The music, conversations, media, and habits within the house all shape the atmosphere. Dr Yonggi Cho understood that prayer and spiritual order must shape the environment if God's presence is to rest there. If a home is constantly fed with confusion, carnality, and negativity, revival will struggle to remain strong.

4. Revival in the Home Requires Leadership and Intentionality

Someone must take responsibility to lead. Joshua declared, "As for me and my house, we will serve the Lord." This kind of leadership is essential. Prophet Uebert Angel teaches that what is not intentionally guided can drift. Revival in the home requires someone to stand, pray, declare, and lead the atmosphere toward God consistently.

5. A Revived Home Becomes a Witness to Others

When God revives a home, it does not only affect the family — it affects visitors, neighbours, and future generations. Reinhard Bonnke carried a global burden, but revival often begins in homes before it spreads to nations. A house filled with peace, prayer, truth, and the presence of God becomes a light to the world. Never underestimate what God can do through a revived household.
