Thank you for your invitation to participate in a public community forum regarding the issues of our community, Commonwealth, and country. Serving as a member of Congress is not a role to be taken lightly, and the myriad issues that a federal representative must be knowledgeable about, speak to, and act upon are vast.

Chrissy has represented our community in an accessible, transparent, and pragmatic way for nearly eight years. Her numerous open town halls, public statements, votes, and her openness with her concerns about this current administration and previous administrations are publicly available on her website and on other available platforms such as media interviews and social media. She stands by her record.

In order for any joint discussion to be truly helpful to our voters and constituents of PA-06, more publicly available information from you is first necessary. The election is two months away, and at this point, you have not put forward any position on some of the most critical issues currently facing our country — issues that a member of Congress is expected to be knowledgeable about and stand in favor of or in opposition to.

Before moving forward with any planning of a forum of any kind, we respectfully request that you expand your website to make it clear to voters where you stand on some of the biggest priorities of the Republican Party in Washington including the SAVE Act and access to the ballot, the validity of the 2020 election, DHS/ICE funding and presence in our communities, rights of organized Labor, the status of the federal minimum wage, reproductive rights, the Epstein files, and the war in Iran. You also must be clear with whether you support President Trump. If elected, you will face extreme pressure to support President Trump, and his unprecedented expansion of executive power and unauthorized spending — along with your party's agenda.
